Pursuant to Sections 330 and 331 of Title 11 of the United States Code, §§ 101-1532 (the "<u>Bankruptcy Code</u>"), Rule 2016 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure (the "<u>Bankruptcy</u> <u>Rules</u>"), Rule 2016-2 of the Local Rules of Bankruptcy Practice and Procedure of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware (the "<u>Local Rules</u>"), and the *Order Establishing Procedures for Interim Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses for Retained Professionals*, dated July 31, 2024 [Docket No. 350] (the "<u>Interim Compensation Order</u>"), Kurtzman Carson Consultants, LLC dba Verita Global ("<u>Verita</u>"), administrative advisor for the above-captioned debtors (the "<u>Debtors</u>"), hereby submits its final fee application (this "<u>Fee</u> Application") for allowance of compensation and authorization of payment for professional

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services provided in the amount of \$83,862.75 for the period from June 17, 2024 through and including October 17, 2024 (the "Fee Period"). In support of this Fee Application, Verita represents as follows:

JURISDICTION

1. The United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware (the "<u>Court</u>") has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334 and the *Amended Standing Order of Reference* from the United States District Court for the District of Delaware, dated February 29, 2012. This matter is a core proceeding within the meaning of 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2), and Verita confirms its consent pursuant to Local Rule 9013-1(f) to the entry of a final order by the Court in connection with this Fee Application to the extent that it is later determined that the Court, absent consent of the parties, cannot enter final orders or judgments in connection herewith consistent with Article III of the United States Constitution.

2. Venue in this Court is proper pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409.

3. The statutory bases for the relief requested herein are section 330 and 331 of the Bankruptcy Code, Bankruptcy Rule 2016, and Local Rules 2016-1 and 2016-2.

BACKGROUND

4. On June 17, 2024 (the "<u>Original Petition Date</u>"), Fisker Group, Inc. filed a voluntary petition under chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code. On June 19, 2024 (the "<u>Subsequent Petition Date</u>," and together with the Original Petition Date, the "<u>Petition Date</u>"), the other Debtors filed voluntary petitions under chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code with the Court.

5. On June 20, 2024, the Debtors filed an application to employ Verita as its claims and noticing agent (in such capacity, the "<u>Claims and Noticing Agent</u>") pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 156(c) and Local Rule 2002-1(f) [Docket No. 35] (the "<u>Section 156(c) Application</u>"), which was approved by the Court on July 2, 2024 [Docket No. 109] (the "<u>Section 156(c) Order</u>").

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6. Given that the administration of these chapter 11 cases would require Verita to perform duties outside the scope of 28 U.S.C. § 156(c), the Debtors supplemented the Section 156(c) Application with an application to retain Verita to perform certain services as the Debtors' administrative advisor in these chapter 11 cases (in such capacity, the "Administrative Advisor"). On June 25, 2024, the Debtors filed the *Application of Debtors for Authority to Employ and Retain Kurtzman Carson Consultants, LLC dba Verita Global as Administrative Advisor to the Debtors Nunc Pro Tunc to the Petition Date* [Docket No. 71]. On July 18, 2024, the Court entered the *Order Authorizing the Debtors to Employ and Retain Kurtzman Carson Consultants, LLC dba Verita Global as Administrative Advisor to the Petition Date* [Docket No. 71]. On July 18, 2024, the Court entered the *Order Authorizing the Debtors to Employ and Retain Kurtzman Carson Consultants, LLC dba Verita Global as Administrative Advisor to the Debtors to Employ and Retain Kurtzman Carson Consultants, LLC dba Verita Global as Administrative Advisor to the Debtors Nunc Pro Tunc to the Petition Date* [Docket No. 71]. The Retention Order authorized the Debtors to compensate Verita in accordance with the Bankruptcy Code, the Bankruptcy Rules, the Local Rules, and any orders entered in these cases governing professional compensation and reimbursement for services rendered and charges and disbursements incurred.

- 7. The Retention Order authorizes Verita to provide the following services:
 - (a) assist with, among other things, the preparation of the Debtors' schedules of assets and liabilities, schedules of executory contracts and unexpired leases, and statements of financial affairs;
 - (b) assist with, among other things, solicitation, balloting, tabulation and calculation of votes, as well as prepare any appropriate reports required in furtherance of confirmation of any chapter 11 plan;
 - (c) generate an official ballot certification and testify, if necessary, in support of the ballot tabulation results for any chapter 11 plan(s) in these Chapter 11 Cases;
 - (d) generate, provide and assist with claims objections, exhibits, claims reconciliation and related matters; and
 - (e) provide such other claims processing, noticing, solicitation, balloting and administrative services described in the Services Agreement, but not included in the Section 156(c) Application, as may be requested by the Debtors from time to time.

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8. The amounts sought in this Application do not include any fees that may be payable by the Debtors for services provided by Verita under the Section 156(c) Order. Procedures for the payment of such fees and disbursements are separately addressed in the Section 156(c) Order. Additionally, no fees and disbursements for services provided to the Debtors under the Retention Order are or will be sought to be paid under the Section 156(c) Order.

9. All services for which compensation is requested by Verita were performed on behalf of the Debtors.

SUMMARY AND VALUATION OF SERVICES

10. The amount of time spent by each employee providing services to the Debtors for the period from October 1, 2024 through October 17, 2024 is detailed in line item listings of time entries and descriptive detail set forth herein and in the invoice attached hereto as <u>Exhibit</u> A. These are Verita's normal hourly rates of compensation for work of this character. The reasonable value of the services rendered by Verita for the Fee Period as Administrative Advisor to the Debtors in these chapter 11 cases is \$83,862.75 due for fees. Verita is not seeking reimbursement for any expenses in this Application.

11. During the Fee Period, Verita's professionals performed 262.7 hours assisting the Debtors and their professionals with the preparation of the Schedules of Assets and Liabilities and Statements of Financial Affairs (the "<u>Schedules and Statements</u>"). This included frequent communication with the Debtors and their professionals regarding data, timelines, preparation status, and updated. Verita professionals also gathered, organized, and tracked the Schedules and Statements data, and prepared and updated multiple drafts of the Schedules and Statements.

12. Verita professionals additionally performed 205.5 hours of work related to the Debtors' solicitation. This included reviewing and commenting on solicitation documents and

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procedures and correspondence with the Debtors and their professionals regarding the solicitation and timeline. Verita professionals also reviewed ballots, prepared the voting summary and voting declaration, corresponded with third parties regarding the solicitation, and attended the confirmation hearing.

13. Verita believes that the time entries included in <u>Exhibit A</u> are in compliance with the requirements of Local Rule 2016-2.

14. In accordance with the factors enumerated in section 330 of the Bankruptcy Code, Verita submits that the amount requested is fair and reasonable given (a) the complexity of these cases, (b) the time expended, (c) the nature and extent of services rendered, (d) the value of such services, and (e) the costs of comparable services other than in a case under this title.

CONCLUSION

WHEREFORE, Verita respectfully requests that the Court enter an Order: (i) granting the Fee Application and allowing compensation in the amount of \$83,862.75; (ii) directing payment by the Debtors of any outstanding amounts; and (iii) granting such other and further relief as the Court deems just and proper.
