Addendum No. 1 to the December 27, 2017 Letter Agreement Between Highland Capital Management, L.P. and Coleman Research Group, Inc.

This Addendum updates certain terms to the above-referenced agreement (the "Agreement"). Only those terms specified below are updated, the remaining terms of the Agreement shall continue. All terms used but not otherwise defined herein shall have the meanings assigned to such terms in the Agreement.

Period: The 12-month period beginning on January 1, 2019 (the "Period").

Services: Unlimited Research Services Credits, a unit that may be applied towards the purchase of Research Services.

Fee: \$175,000 due in two equal installments of \$87,500 with the first installment due upon execution of this Addendum Number 1 to the Agreement and the second installment due on July 1, 2019.
