There is currently a class action lawsuit pending against Progexion Holdings, Inc., Progexion Teleservices, Inc., Progexion Marketing, Inc., Progexion ASG, Inc., Progexion IP, Inc., eFolks,

LLC, Creditrepair.com, Inc., Credit.Com, Inc., and John C. Heath, Attorney at Law, PLLC, in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware, Adv. Proc. No. 23-ap-50396 (CTG). In it, Kirsten Hansen (“Plaintiff”) sued alleging she was terminated along with other employees without advance notice under the federal Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act, 29 U.S.C. § 2101 *et seq.*, (the “WARN Act”). The Defendants deny liability, invoking several defenses under the WARN Act.

Plaintiff and Defendants (collectively, the “Parties”) have reached a proposed settlement of this lawsuit in which money would be distributed to the Class Members, who are represented by the Class Representative and Class Counsel (each defined below). The Bankruptcy Court has authorized the sending of this notice to you as a Class Member (defined below).

YOU ARE NOT BEING SUED. You should review this notice carefully as you may be entitled to receive money from the Settlement and your rights may be affected by the Settlement.

You did not receive prior notice of this class action. You are receiving this notice now because Class Counsel has concluded based on its review of the books and records of the Defendants that you are a member of the Class and may be owed damages. (Capitalized terms are each defined below).

INTRODUCTION

There is a lawsuit currently pending in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware (the “Class Action”) brought under the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act, 29 U.S.C. §§ 2101 *et seq* (the “WARN Act”), 29 U.S.C. § 2101 *et seq.* The Plaintiff on the one hand, and the Defendants on the other hand, have reached a proposed settlement of the Class Action (the “Settlement”) under which the benefits described below will be provided to the members of the Class. The claims set forth in the Class Action were disputed by the Defendants. After extensive good faith negotiations, the parties were able to reach the proposed Settlement, which all parties, including Class Counsel (defined below), believe is fair and reasonable under the circumstances.

This Notice constitutes notice to the Class of (a) the proposed Settlement of the Class Action; (b) a description of the proposed Settlement; (c) the date of the court hearing for final approval of the Settlement; and (d) the right of each member of the Class to opt-out or object to the Settlement, and to appear at the hearing at which the Court will consider the final approval of the Settlement.

DESCRIPTION OF THE CLASS ACTION

Beginning on or about April 5, 2023, Plaintiff and other employees of Defendants were allegedly terminated without cause.

On June 4, 2023, each of the Defendants filed voluntary petitions for relief under chapter 11 of Title 11 of the United States Code in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware. The chapter 11 cases are being jointly administered under Case No. 23-10718 (CTG).

On June 5, 2023, Plaintiff filed a Class Action Adversary Proceeding Complaint against Defendants in this Court for alleged violation of the WARN Act, asserting that Defendants are liable to Plaintiff and the other similarly situated former employees for damages in the amount of 60 days' pay and ERISA benefits.

On July 5, 2023, Defendants filed an Answer generally denying Plaintiff's allegations and asserting affirmative defenses.

On August 4, 2023, Plaintiff filed a Motion for Class Certification and Related Relief (Adv. D.I. 5), which Defendants opposed on August 18, 2023 (Adv. D.I. 8). On October 24, 2023, the Court granted the Motion for Class Certification and Related Relief (Adv. D.I. 29), and on November 8, 2023, issued an Order (Adv. D.I. 36) certifying a Class defined as:

Plaintiff and other similarly situated employees of Defendants: (i) who worked at, received assignments from, or reported to any of the Defendants' sites, (ii) who were terminated within 90 days of April 5, 2023, and (iii) who have not filed a timely request to opt-out of the class.

In the Order certifying the Class, the Court appointed Kirsten Hansen the Class Representative and her counsel the Class Counsel. On December 8, 2023, *Notice of Class Action* was mailed to the members of the Class advising them of the January 7, 2024, deadline to exercise their right to opt-out of the Class. One Class Member opted out of the Class.

Recently, the Parties determined that an additional 131 terminated employees fall within the definition of the certified class. If this is the first notice you have received of the class action, your Notice includes an opt-out form.

On November 22, 2023, Defendants filed a Motion for Summary Judgment, which the Plaintiff opposed on October 20, 2023. On November 1, 2023, the Court denied Defendants' Motion for Summary Judgment and set trial for December 11, 2023.

No court has made any finding related to liability. The Parties have concluded that it is in their best interests to settle this lawsuit to avoid the risk, expense, and uncertain outcome associated with continued litigation. The Settlement was reached through extensive arm's-length negotiations among the Parties.

By order dated April 4, 2024, the Bankruptcy Court (i) preliminarily approved the Settlement; (ii) approved this notice, and (iii) scheduled the Fairness Hearing for final approval of the Settlement.

THE PROPOSED SETTLEMENT

The terms of the Settlement are set forth in the Settlement Agreement. The following description of the proposed Settlement is only a summary and is qualified in its entirety by the terms of the Settlement Agreement, and any inconsistency shall be governed by the terms of the Settlement Agreement. You may request the complete text of the Settlement Agreement from Class Counsel René S. The terms of the Settlement Agreement are summarized as follows:

- a) **Settlement Amount (Allowed Class Claim):** . The Class, in full and final settlement of the WARN Action, shall be granted an aggregate allowed priority class claim against Defendants pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §507(a)(4) of \$1,450,000 (the “**Allowed Class Claim**”), which amount shall be subject to the 11 U.S.C. §507(a)(4) statutory cap. Of that amount, \$1,200,000 has been paid to Class Counsel for distribution as set forth in paragraph b), below, and an additional maximum of \$250,000 for such distribution shall be paid from remaining funds in Defendants’ wind-down budget, if any, at the conclusion of the bankruptcy cases. The Allowed Class Claim is inclusive of all amounts payable in connection with the Settlement, including without limitation, Class Counsel’s Fees and Expenses, the Class Representative Service Payment, Employer Payroll Taxes, costs of the Settlement Administrator and any other applicable, federal, state, or local taxes. Neither the Plaintiff, any Class Member, or any of their counsels or representatives shall have any claim against any of the Debtors, the Reorganized Debtors, or their estates arising from or related to the actions alleged in the Complaint and the Reorganized Debtors shall modify the claims registers to reflect such without the need for further action from the Court.

- b) **Distribution of the Allowed Class Claim:** The Allowed Class Claim (after being reduced on account of the Class Representative Service Payment (defined below), Class Counsel’s Fees and Expenses, shall be distributed to individual Class Members on a pro rata basis (their “**Pro Rata Share**”) based upon each individual Class Member’s (a) regular monthly gross wages or salary and any benefits under any employee benefit plan, (b) their hire date, notice date and termination date, based on Defendants’ books and records, and (c) any voluntary payments they received at termination (the “**Back Pay**”). The term “**pro rata**” shall mean the quotient of each Class Member’s Back Pay for the Back-Pay Period over the aggregate Back Pay for all Class Members. The Back-Pay Period shall be up to 60 days as calculated pursuant to the WARN Act. No Class Member’s share of the recovery from the qualified settlement fund may exceed \$15,150, which is the applicable priority cap pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §507(a)(4) of the Bankruptcy Code.

- c) **Class Representative Service Payment:** Subject to the Bankruptcy Court's approval, the Class Representative shall be entitled to a one-time payment of \$25,000 payable from the Settlement Amount in addition to her pro-rata share of the Settlement Amount.
- d) **Class Counsel's Fees and Expenses:** Subject to the Court's approval, Class Counsel shall receive attorneys' fees of one-third (1/3) of the Allowed Class Claim amount, net of 1) the Class Representative Service Payment, 2) Class Counsel's expenses, and 3) the cost of the Settlement Administrator. Class Counsel's expenses and the cost of the Settlement Administrator shall not exceed \$100,000.
- e) **Settlement Effective Date:** The Settlement Agreement shall become effective on the date on which the final settlement order becomes a "final order" (the "**Settlement Effective Date**"). The final settlement order shall become a final order when the time for taking an appeal under Bankruptcy Rule 8002 has expired or, in the event that an appeal has been taken, the day the final settlement order has been affirmed with no further right of appeal under the Bankruptcy Rules.
- f) **Release:** Upon the Settlement Effective Date, the Class Members, for and on behalf of themselves, and their respective predecessors, successors, assigns, heirs, personal representatives and estates will fully and forever release and discharge, to the extent not previously released and discharged, the Defendants and each of their respective current and former members, subsidiaries and affiliated entities, and each of their respective officers, directors, shareholders, agents, employees, partners, members, accountants, attorneys, representatives and other agents, and all of their respective predecessors, successors and assigns (collectively, the "**Released Parties**"), of and from any and all claims, demands, debts, liabilities, obligations, liens, actions and causes of action, costs, expenses, attorneys' fees, and damages of whatever kind or nature, at law, in equity and otherwise, whether known or unknown, anticipated, suspected, or disclosed, that the Releasing Parties may now have or hereafter may have against the Released Parties, including, but not limited to, any claims related to or based upon the WARN Act, or any other federal, state, or local laws or regulations of similar effect arising from or out of or relating to the allegations asserted in the Complaint.
- g) **Proofs of Claim** – The Final Approval Order shall provide that any and all proofs of claim filed on account of liabilities asserted, assertible, arising from or out of or relating to the allegations asserted in the Complaint or the Adversary Proceeding by Class Members in the Settlement Class shall be disallowed and expunged from the Defendants' claims register on the Effective Date. Nothing in this Settlement Agreement shall waive or limit defenses available to the Defendants and their successors and assigns against a proof of claim that has been or may be filed against the Defendants in these Bankruptcy Cases.
- h) **Residual Funds:** Any distributions from the Qualified Settlement Fund to Class Members that are not deposited or presented for payment within one hundred eighty (180) days of the distribution shall be deemed residual funds and be distributed to anyone omitted from the Class, who Class Counsel qualify to be Class Members, with any remaining funds

donated to Towards Justice, a non-profit 501(c)(3) charitable organization which advocates on behalf of employees' rights.

- i) **Claim Treatment:** The Class Representative agrees, on behalf herself and all Class Members, to accept the Settlement as treatment of their alleged claims in the Chapter 11 Cases arising out of or relating to the WARN Act and that such treatment with respect to the Class Representative and the Class Members complies with Section 1129, including 1129(a)(9), of the Bankruptcy Code.

The proposed Settlement will be presented to the Bankruptcy Court for final approval at the Fairness Hearing to be held on **May 20, 2024 at 12:00 p.m. (ET) at 824 North Market Street, 3rd Floor, Courtroom 7, Wilmington, DE 19801.**

The Bankruptcy Court will, at that time, decide whether the Settlement is fair, reasonable, and adequate to the Class Members and whether the request of Class Counsel for attorneys' fees and expenses should be approved. As explained below, you have the right to object to the proposed Settlement including the Class Counsel's request for attorneys' fees and expenses and to appear in person at the Fairness Hearing to be heard, or to engage counsel to do so on your behalf.

WHAT TO DO IF YOU WANT TO RECEIVE PART OF THE SETTLEMENT

To receive your share of the Settlement, there is nothing you need to do. Your check will be mailed to you following the final approval of the Settlement by the Bankruptcy Court and the conclusion of the bankruptcy cases when the total settlement fund amount will be known. If the name or address information provided on this form is incorrect, please update your information with Class Counsel by emailing rllp@raisnerroupinian.com or calling (212) 221-1747.

WHAT HAPPENS IF YOU DO NOTHING IN RESPONSE TO THIS NOTICE

If you do nothing in response to this notice, a check will be sent to you, and you will be bound by the terms of the Settlement, including the release, described above. Therefore, you will not have the right to pursue any claims covered by the release against Defendants and will be forever barred from doing so.

HOW TO OPT OUT

If you wish to be a member of the Class and share in the settlement, you do not need to do anything. You will receive the benefits that you, as a Class Member, may be entitled to receive. If you do nothing, you will automatically be a Class Member and be bound by any judgment (whether favorable or unfavorable) or court-approved settlement in the case, including the Settlement described in this notice.

If you do NOT wish to be in the class and wish to be EXCLUDED from the settlement and NOT share in any settlement payments, you may opt-out of the Class by filling out the attached

“Exclusion Form” and signing and mailing that form to: Class Counsel, Raisner Roupinian LLP, 270 Madison Ave., Ste. 1801, New York, New York 10016, Attn: René S. Roupinian, Esq.

The form must be postmarked no later than **May 6, 2024**. All requests for exclusion postmarked after that date will not be effective, and any person who sends a late form will be a member of the class in this Action and will be bound in the same way and to the same extent as all other Class Members.

HOW TO OBJECT

If you believe the proposed Settlement is unfair or otherwise wish to object to the proposed Settlement, including Class Counsel’s request for attorneys’ fees and expenses, you must do so by mailing a written statement bearing the caption of this case that appears on the first page of this notice setting forth the reason(s) for your objection to the Clerk of the Bankruptcy Court (the “Clerk”), United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware, 824 North Market Street, Wilmington, DE 19801, and sending copies to (i) Class Counsel, Raisner Roupinian LLP, 270 Madison Avenue, Suite 1801, New York, New York 10016, Attn: René S. Roupinian; and (ii) Bankruptcy counsel for Defendants, Michael Yurkewicz, Klehr Harrison Harvey Branzburg LLP, 919 N. Market St., Suite 1000, Wilmington, DE 19801.

Objections must be **RECEIVED** by the Clerk, Class Counsel, and Defendants’ counsel no later than **May 13, 2024** and must include the case name and number, your name, address, and telephone number together with the basis for your objection.

You also have the right, but are not required, to retain counsel to appear for you, to object on your behalf and be heard at the Fairness Hearing at which the Bankruptcy Court will consider whether to finally approve the Settlement. If you do, then you will be responsible for your personal attorney’s fees and costs. You or your counsel may also appear at the Fairness Hearing when the Bankruptcy Court considers your objection and final approval of the Settlement. If your objection is overruled or rejected by the Court, then you will be bound by the Settlement just as if you had not objected.

If you elect to engage counsel, your counsel must file an appearance with the Bankruptcy Court no later than **May 13, 2024** and at that time also file a statement setting forth any objections on your behalf. Copies of the appearance and the objection must be mailed at the same time to (i) Class Counsel, Raisner Roupinian LLP, 270 Madison Avenue, Suite 1801, New York, New York 10016, Attn: René S. Providing you with this notice does not mean that the Bankruptcy Court has any opinion as to the claims or defenses of the Parties. Defendants are not responsible for the contents of this notice.

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NOTICE OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT AND FAIRNESS HEARING

April 19, 2024

TO: CERTAIN FORMER EMPLOYEES OF PGX HOLDINGS, INC. AND ITS AFFILIATES

There is currently a class action lawsuit pending against Progrexion Holdings, Inc., Progrexion Teleservices, Inc., Progrexion Marketing, Inc., Progrexion ASG, Inc., Progrexion IP, Inc., eFolks, LLC, Creditrepair.com, Inc., Credit.Com, Inc., and John C. Heath, Attorney at Law, PLLC, in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware, Adv. Proc. No. 23-ap-50396 (CTG).

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In it, Kirsten Hansen (“Plaintiff”) sued alleging she was terminated along with other employees without advance notice under the federal Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act, 29 U.S.C. § 2101 *et seq.*, (the “WARN Act”). The Defendants deny liability, invoking several defenses under the WARN Act.

Plaintiff and Defendants (collectively, the “Parties”) have reached a proposed settlement of this lawsuit in which money would be distributed to the Class Members, who are represented by the Class Representative and Class Counsel (each defined below). The Bankruptcy Court has authorized the sending of this notice to you as a Class Member (defined below).

YOU ARE NOT BEING SUED. You should review this notice carefully as you may be entitled to receive money from the Settlement and your rights may be affected by the Settlement.

DEFINITION OF THE CLASS

The Bankruptcy Court has preliminarily approved the Settlement, approved this notice, and set a date for a final hearing for approval of the Settlement (the “Fairness Hearing”).

The “Class” that was certified by the Court on November 8, 2023 is defined as: Plaintiff and other similarly situated employees of Defendants: (i) who worked at, received assignments from, or reported to any of the Defendants' sites, (ii) who were terminated within 90 days of April 5, 2023, and (iii) who have not filed a timely request to opt-out of the class.

“Class Members” are defined as a member of the Class.

You have been identified as a Class Member who is eligible to participate in the Settlement.

The “Class Representative” is Plaintiff Hansen, a former employee who initiated this lawsuit.

BACKGROUND

Beginning on or about April 5, 2023, Plaintiff and other employees of Defendants were allegedly terminated without cause.

On June 4, 2023, each of the Defendants filed voluntary petitions for relief under chapter 11 of Title 11 of the United States Code in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware. The chapter 11 cases are being jointly administered under Case No. 23-10718 (CTG).

On June 5, 2023, Plaintiff filed a Class Action Adversary Proceeding Complaint against Defendants in this Court for alleged violation of the WARN Act, asserting that Defendants are liable to Plaintiff and the other similarly situated former employees for damages in the amount of 60 days’ pay and ERISA benefits.

On July 5, 2023, Defendants filed an Answer generally denying Plaintiff’s allegations and asserting affirmative defenses.

On August 4, 2023, Plaintiff filed a Motion for Class Certification and Related Relief (Adv. D.I. 5), which Defendants opposed on August 18, 2023 (Adv. D.I. 8). On October 24, 2023, the Court granted the Motion for Class Certification and Related Relief (Adv. D.I. 29), and on November 8, 2023, issued an Order (Adv. D.I. 36) certifying a Class defined as:

Plaintiff and other similarly situated employees of Defendants: (i) who worked at, received assignments from, or reported to any of the Defendants' sites, (ii) who were terminated within 90 days of April 5, 2023, and (iii) who have not filed a timely request to opt-out of the class.

In the Order certifying the Class, the Court appointed Kirsten Hansen the Class Representative and her counsel the Class Counsel. On December 8, 2023, *Notice of Class Action* was mailed to the 947 members of the Class advising them of the January 7, 2024, deadline to exercise their right to opt-out of the Class. One Class Member opted out of the Class.

Recently, the Parties determined that an additional 131 terminated employees fall within the definition of the certified class. If this is the first notice you have received of the class action, your Notice includes an opt-out form.

On November 22, 2023, Defendants filed a Motion for Summary Judgment, which the Plaintiff opposed on October 20, 2023. On November 1, 2023, the Court denied Defendants' Motion for Summary Judgment and set trial for December 11, 2023.

No court has made any finding related to liability. The Parties have concluded that it is in their best interests to settle this lawsuit to avoid the risk, expense, and uncertain outcome associated with continued litigation. The Settlement was reached through extensive arm's-length negotiations among the Parties.

By order dated April 4, 2024, the Bankruptcy Court (i) preliminarily approved the Settlement; (ii) approved this notice, and (iii) scheduled the Fairness Hearing for final approval of the Settlement.

THE PROPOSED SETTLEMENT

The terms of the Settlement are set forth in the Settlement Agreement. The following description of the proposed Settlement is only a summary and is qualified in its entirety by the terms of the

Settlement Agreement, and any inconsistency shall be governed by the terms of the Settlement Agreement. You may request the complete text of the Settlement Agreement from Class Counsel René S. The terms of the Settlement Agreement are summarized as follows:

- a) **Settlement Amount (Allowed Class Claim):** . The Class, in full and final settlement of the WARN Action, shall be granted an aggregate allowed priority class claim against Defendants pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §507(a)(4) of \$1,450,000 (the “**Allowed Class Claim**”), which amount shall be subject to the 11 U.S.C. §507(a)(4) statutory cap. Of that amount, \$1,200,000 has been paid to Class Counsel for distribution as set forth in paragraph b), below, and an additional maximum of \$250,000 for such distribution shall be paid from remaining funds in Defendants’ wind-down budget, if any, at the conclusion of the bankruptcy cases. The Allowed Class Claim is inclusive of all amounts payable in connection with the Settlement, including without limitation, Class Counsel’s Fees and Expenses, the Class Representative Service Payment, Employer Payroll Taxes, costs of the Settlement Administrator and any other applicable, federal, state, or local taxes. Neither the Plaintiff, any Class Member, or any of their counsels or representatives shall have any claim against any of the Debtors, the Reorganized Debtors, or their estates arising from or related to the actions alleged in the Complaint and the Reorganized Debtors shall modify the claims registers to reflect such without the need for further action from the Court.
- b) **Distribution of the Allowed Class Claim:** The Allowed Class Claim (after being reduced on account of the Class Representative Service Payment (defined below), Class Counsel’s Fees and Expenses, shall be distributed to individual Class Members on a pro rata basis (their “**Pro Rata Share**”) based upon each individual Class Member’s (a) regular monthly gross wages or salary and any benefits under any employee benefit plan, (b) their hire date, notice date and termination date, based on Defendants’ books and records, and (c) any voluntary payments they received at termination (the “**Back Pay**”). The term “**pro rata**” shall mean the quotient of each Class Member’s Back Pay for the Back-Pay Period over the aggregate Back Pay for all Class Members. The Back-Pay Period shall be up to 60 days as calculated pursuant to the WARN Act. No Class Member’s share of the recovery from the qualified settlement fund may exceed \$15,150, which is the applicable priority cap pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §507(a)(4) of the Bankruptcy Code.
- c) **Class Representative Service Payment:** Subject to the Bankruptcy Court’s approval, the Class Representative shall be entitled to a one-time payment of \$25,000 payable from the Settlement Amount in addition to her pro-rata share of the Settlement Amount.
- d) **Class Counsel’s Fees and Expenses:** Subject to the Court’s approval, Class Counsel shall receive attorneys’ fees of one-third (1/3) of the Allowed Class Claim amount, net of 1) the Class Representative Service Payment, 2) Class Counsel’s expenses, and 3) the cost of the Settlement Administrator. Class Counsel’s expenses and the cost of the Settlement Administrator shall not exceed \$100,000.

- e) **Settlement Effective Date:** The Settlement Agreement shall become effective on the date on which the final settlement order becomes a “final order” (the “Settlement Effective Date”). The final settlement order shall become a final order when the time for taking an appeal under Bankruptcy Rule 8002 has expired or, in the event that an appeal has been taken, the day the final settlement order has been affirmed with no further right of appeal under the Bankruptcy Rules.
- f) **Release:** Upon the Settlement Effective Date, the Class Members, for and on behalf of themselves, and their respective predecessors, successors, assigns, heirs, personal representatives and estates will fully and forever release and discharge, to the extent not previously released and discharged, the Defendants and each of their respective current and former members, subsidiaries and affiliated entities, and each of their respective officers, directors, shareholders, agents, employees, partners, members, accountants, attorneys, representatives and other agents, and all of their respective predecessors, successors and assigns (collectively, the “**Released Parties**”), of and from any and all claims, demands, debts, liabilities, obligations, liens, actions and causes of action, costs, expenses, attorneys’ fees, and damages of whatever kind or nature, at law, in equity and otherwise, whether known or unknown, anticipated, suspected, or disclosed, that the Releasing Parties may now have or hereafter may have against the Released Parties, including, but not limited to, any claims related to or based upon the WARN Act, or any other federal, state, or local laws or regulations of similar effect arising from or out of or relating to the allegations asserted in the Complaint.
- g) **Proofs of Claim** – The Final Approval Order shall provide that any and all proofs of claim filed on account of liabilities asserted, assertible, arising from or out of or relating to the allegations asserted in the Complaint or the Adversary Proceeding by Class Members in the Settlement Class shall be disallowed and expunged from the Defendants’ claims register on the Effective Date. Nothing in this Settlement Agreement shall waive or limit defenses available to the Defendants and their successors and assigns against a proof of claim that has been or may be filed against the Defendants in these Bankruptcy Cases.
- h) **Residual Funds:** Any distributions from the Qualified Settlement Fund to Class Members that are not deposited or presented for payment within one hundred eighty (180) days of the distribution shall be deemed residual funds and be distributed to anyone omitted from the Class, who Class Counsel qualify to be Class Members, with any remaining funds donated to Towards Justice, a non-profit 501(c)(3) charitable organization which advocates on behalf of employees’ rights.
- i) **Claim Treatment:** The Class Representative agrees, on behalf herself and all Class Members, to accept the Settlement as treatment of their alleged claims in the Chapter 11 Cases arising out of or relating to the WARN Act and that such treatment with respect to the Class Representative and the Class Members complies with Section 1129, including 1129(a)(9), of the Bankruptcy Code.

The proposed Settlement will be presented to the Bankruptcy Court for final approval at the Fairness Hearing to be held on **May 20, 2024 at 12:00 p.m. (ET) at 824 North Market Street, 3rd Floor, Courtroom 7, Wilmington, DE 19801.**

The Bankruptcy Court will, at that time, decide whether the Settlement is fair, reasonable, and adequate to the Class Members and whether the request of Class Counsel for attorneys' fees and expenses should be approved. As explained below, you have the right to object to the proposed Settlement including the Class Counsel's request for attorneys' fees and expenses and to appear in person at the Fairness Hearing to be heard, or to engage counsel to do so on your behalf.

WHAT TO DO IF YOU WANT TO RECEIVE PART OF THE SETTLEMENT

To receive your share of the Settlement, there is nothing you need to do. Your check will be mailed to you following the final approval of the Settlement by the Bankruptcy Court and the conclusion of the bankruptcy cases when the total settlement fund amount will be known. If the name or address information provided on this form is incorrect, please update your information with Class Counsel by emailing rllp@raisnerroupinian.com or calling 212 221-1747.

WHAT HAPPENS IF YOU DO NOTHING IN RESPONSE TO THIS NOTICE

If you do nothing in response to this notice, a check will be sent to you, and you will be bound by the terms of the Settlement, including the release, described above. Therefore, you will not have the right to pursue any claims covered by the release against Defendants and will be forever barred from doing so.

OBJECTIONS

If you believe the proposed Settlement is unfair or otherwise wish to object to the proposed Settlement, including Class Counsel's request for attorneys' fees and expenses, you must do so by mailing a written statement bearing the caption of this case that appears on the first page of this notice setting forth the reason(s) for your objection to the Clerk of the Bankruptcy Court (the "Clerk"), United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware, 824 North Market Street, Wilmington, DE 19801, and sending copies to (i) Class Counsel, Raisner Roupinian LLP, 270 Madison Avenue, Suite 1801, New York, New York 10016, Attn: René S. Roupinian; and (ii) Bankruptcy counsel for Defendants, Michael Yurkewicz, Klehr Harrison Harvey Branzburg LLP, 919 N. Market St., Suite 1000, Wilmington, DE 19801.

Objections must be **RECEIVED** by the Clerk, Class Counsel, and Defendants' counsel no later than **May 13, 2024** and must include the case name and number, your name, address, and telephone number together with the basis for your objection.

You also have the right, but are not required, to retain counsel to appear for you, to object on your behalf and be heard at the Fairness Hearing at which the Bankruptcy Court will consider whether to finally approve the Settlement. If you do, then you will be responsible for your personal attorney's fees and costs. You or your counsel may also appear at the Fairness Hearing when the Bankruptcy Court considers your objection and final approval of the Settlement. If your objection

is overruled or rejected by the Court, then you will be bound by the Settlement just as if you had not objected.

If you elect to engage counsel, your counsel must file an appearance with the Bankruptcy Court no later than **May 13, 2024** and at that time also file a statement setting forth any objections on your behalf. Copies of the appearance and the objection must be mailed at the same time to (i) Class Counsel, Raisner Roupinian LLP, 270 Madison Avenue, Suite 1801, New York, New York 10016, Attn: René S.
