ORDER PURSUANT TO 28 U.S.C. § 1452 AND BANKRUPTCY RULES 9006(b) AND 9027 EXTENDING THE LIQUIDATING TRUSTEE’S TIME TO FILE NOTICES OF REMOVAL OF CLAIMS AND CAUSES OF ACTION IN CIVIL ACTIONS

Upon the *Liquidating Trustee’s Fifth Motion Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1452 and Bankruptcy Rules 9006(b) and 9027 for Entry of an Order Extending the Time to File Notices of Removal of Claims and Causes of Action in Civil Actions* (the “Motion”);² finding that the Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157(b) and 1334; and finding that this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2); and finding that the Court has authority to enter a final order in this matter consistent with Article III of the United States Constitution; and finding that venue of this proceeding and the Motion is proper in this district pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409; and due and proper notice of the Motion having been given; and after due deliberation and it appearing that sufficient cause exists for granting the requested relief;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. The Motion is granted as set forth herein.
2. The time period provided by Bankruptcy Rule 9027 within which the Liquidating

Trustee may file notices of removal of civil actions is extended through and including February 5, 2025.




3. The February 5, 2025 deadline to file notices of removal applies to all matters specified in Bankruptcy Rule 9027(a)(2).

4. This Order is without prejudice to the Liquidating Trustee's right to seek further extensions of the time to file notices of removal of any civil actions under Bankruptcy Rule 9027(a).

5. The Court shall retain jurisdiction to hear and determine all matters arising from or related to the implementation of this Order.
