This matter having come before the Honorable Jolie A. Russo on the Receiver's

Objection To And Request For Disallowance Of The Proofs of Claim Filed By Elliot Hayes

d/b/a Global Merchant House [Dkt. 943] (the "Objection"), and the Court, being fully advised in

the premises, now, therefore,

THE COURT FINDS as follows:

On March 10, 2016, the Securities and Exchange Commission ("SEC") filed a

complaint in this Court against the Entity Defendants¹ and three individual defendants, Robert J.

Jesenik, Brian A. Oliver, and N. Scott Gillis.

B. On March 16, 2016, pursuant to the Stipulated Interim Order Appointing

Receiver, the Receiver was appointed as receiver for the Entity Defendants and 43 related

entities on an interim basis (the "Interim Receivership Order"). On April 14, 2016, pursuant to

the Final Receivership Order, the Receiver was appointed as receiver of the Entity Defendants

and 43 related entities on a final basis.

C. On April 25, 2019, the Court fixed a Claims Bar Date of July 31, 2019; approved

the manner of notice of the Claims Bar Date; and approved the Proof of Claim Form, the Claims

Procedure, and associated exhibits and attachments (the "Claims Bar Date and Procedures

Order"). The Claims Bar Date has passed.

D. On August 19, 2019, Elliot Hayes d/b/a Global Merchant House ("Mr. Hayes")

submitted two proofs of claim, each asserting a Creditor Claim, one in the amount of \$15,000.00

and one in the amount of \$150,000.00 (the "Disputed Hayes Claims"). Mr. Hayes confirmed in

writing that his \$150,000.00 claim replaced the earlier filed \$15,000.00 claim.

E. On March 31, 2020 the Court entered its Findings of Fact and Conclusions of

Law approving the Receiver's Distribution Plan (the "Court-approved Distribution Plan").

¹ Capitalized terms not otherwise defined in this Order shall have the meanings ascribed to them

in the Objection.

F. The Court-approved Distribution Plan provides for the classification and

treatment of Allowed Claims, including what constitutes a Creditor Claim.

G. The Disputed Hayes Claims were not timely filed and do not include a claim for

services provided to the Receivership or any Receivership Entity.

H. The documents attached to the proofs of claim are inadequate to support the

subject claims. One document is an invoice in the amount of \$7,109.50 for legal services related

to corporate formation and foreign tax issues. Mr. Hayes has not provided any evidence that the

legal services relate to his claims or that the invoice was paid.

I. Mr. Hayes has not provided any evidence that his efforts developed additional

investors for Aequitas and the Receiver is unaware of any such investors.

J. The Disputed Hayes Claims do not comply with the definition of a Creditor Claim

nor do they evidence any other form of claim validly asserted against the Receivership as

determined in accordance with the Court-approved Distribution Plan.

K. Due, timely, and adequate notice of the Objection was given, and such notice was

good, sufficient, and appropriate under the circumstances. No other or further notice of the

Objection is or shall be required.

The Court having reviewed the Objection, and being duly advised,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND DECREED as follows.

1. The Objection is granted in its entirety.

2. The proofs of claim filed by Elliot Hayes d/b/a Global Merchant House are

disallowed in their entirety and no distribution will be paid on account of such claims from the

Receivership Estate or the Aequitas Qualified Settlement Fund Irrevocable Trust.
