APPLICATION OF THE OFFICIAL COMMITTEE OF UNSECURED CREDITORS FOR AN ORDER AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE EMPLOYMENT AND RETENTION OF ORRICK, HERRINGTON & SUTCLIFFE LLP AS **COUNSEL, EFFECTIVE AS OF AUGUST 19, 2025**

The Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors (the "Committee") appointed in the chapter 11 cases of the above-captioned debtors and debtors-in-possession (collectively, the "Debtors"), hereby files this application (the "Application"), pursuant to sections 328(a) and 1103(a) of title 11 of the United States Code, 11 U.S.C. §§ 101-1532 (as amended, the "Bankruptcy Code"), rules 2014 and 5002 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure (the "Bankruptcy Rules"), and rule 2014-1 of the Local Rules of Bankruptcy Practice and Procedure of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware (as amended, the "Local Rules"), for the entry of an order, substantially in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A, authorizing and approving the employment and retention of Orrick, Herrington & Sutcliffe LLP ("Orrick") as counsel to the Committee, effective as of August 19, 2025. In support of this Application, the Committee submits the Declaration of Mark Franke, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit B (the "Franke <u>Declaration</u>") along with the Declaration of Kelly Weiss on behalf of Aaron Clevenger (c/o

Wasserman Music LLC) ("<u>Wasserman</u>"), Co-Chairperson of the Committee, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit C (the "Weiss Declaration"), and respectfully states as follows:

BACKGROUND

- 1. On August 4, 2025 (the "<u>Petition Date</u>"), the Debtors filed with this Court voluntary petitions for relief under chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code.
- 2. The Debtors have continued in the possession of their property and have continued to operate and manage their businesses as debtors in possession pursuant to sections 1107(a) and 1108 of the Bankruptcy Code.
- 3. On August 18, 2025, the United States Trustee for Region 3 (the "<u>U.S. Trustee</u>") appointed a seven-member Committee consisting of: (i) Heini Limited Liability Company; (ii) Nova Traffic AG; (iii) Gateway Productions, Inc.; (iv) Lauren Bair; (v) Wasserman; (vi) Christie Lites New York LLC; and (vii) Nightmode Video, Inc.
- 4. The Committee selected Orrick to serve as counsel, and Morris James LLP ("Morris James") to serve as Delaware co-counsel.
 - 5. No trustee or examiner has been appointed in these chapter 11 cases.

JURISDICTION

- 6. The Court has jurisdiction over this Application pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334. Venue is proper in this District pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409. This is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2). The statutory predicates for the relief requested herein are sections 328(a) and 1103(a) of the Bankruptcy Code, Bankruptcy Rules 2014 and 5002, and Local Rule 2014-1.
- 7. Pursuant to Local Rule 9013-1(f), the Committee consents to the entry of a final judgment or order with respect to the Application, even if it is determined that the Court, absent

consent of the parties, cannot enter final orders or judgments consistent with Article III of the United States Constitution.

RELIEF REQUESTED

- 8. By this Application, pursuant to sections 328(a) and 1103(a) of the Bankruptcy Code and Bankruptcy Rule 2014, the Committee requests entry of the proposed order attached hereto as Exhibit A, authorizing and approving the employment and retention of Orrick, effective as of August 19, 2025 in connection with these chapter 11 cases. By separate application, the Committee will request that the Court approve the retention and employment of Delaware cocounsel Morris James.
- 9. The Committee respectfully submits that it will be necessary to employ and retain Orrick pursuant to sections 328(a) and 1103(a) of the Bankruptcy Code to render the following services, among others, as directed by the Committee:
 - Advise the Committee with respect to its rights, powers and duties in these cases;
 - Assist, advise and represent the Committee in analyzing the Debtors' assets and liabilities, including analyzing the claims of the Debtors' creditors and the Debtors' capital structure and negotiating with holders of claims and equity interests;
 - Assist and advise the Committee with regarding to any proposed sale(s) or disposition(s) of the Debtors' assets, including issues concerning any potential competing bidders and the auction process;
 - Attend meetings and negotiate with the representatives of the Debtors;
 - Assist and advise the Committee in its examination and analysis of the conduct of the Debtors' affairs;
 - Assist the Committee in the review, analysis and negotiation of any plan(s) that may be filed and to assist the Committee in the review, analysis and negotiation of the disclosure statements accompanying any plan(s);
 - Investigate and determine the value of unencumbered assets;

- Analyze and negotiate the budget and monitor the Debtors' financial performance in chapter 11;
- Assist and advise the Committee with respect to its communications with the general unsecured creditor body regarding significant matters in these cases;
- Review and analyze the work product of the Debtors' management and advisors and report to the Committee;
- Provide the Committee with legal advice in relation to the chapter 11 cases;
- Take all necessary action to protect and preserve the interests of unsecured creditors, including, without limitation, the prosecution of actions on its behalf, negotiations concerning all litigation in which the Debtors are involved, and review and analysis of all claims filed against the Debtors' estates;
- Prepare and file on behalf of the Committee all necessary motions, applications, answers, memoranda of law, orders, reports and papers in support of positions taken by the Committee;
- Appear, as appropriate, before this Court, the appellate courts, and other courts in which matters may be heard and to protect the interests of the Committee before said courts and the U.S. Trustee;
- Review and analyze discovery documents provided by the Debtors and other parties in interest in connection with the Committee's investigations;
- Perform such other legal services in these cases as may be required and are deemed to be in the interests of the Committee and unsecured creditors in accordance with the Committee's powers and duties as set forth in the Bankruptcy Code; and
- Advise and assist with respect to other matters as the Committee may request from time to time, in each case without duplication of the services of Morris James or any other Committee professional.
- 10. Orrick has agreed to act on behalf of, and to render such services to, the Committee.
- 11. In performance of such duties, Orrick shall report to the Committee.
- 12. Orrick's retention by the Committee is necessary because Orrick has recognized expertise and extensive experience and knowledge in the field of business reorganizations and

liquidations under the Bankruptcy Code and insolvency and commercial law, and is well qualified to undertake the responsibilities as counsel to the Committee.

DISCLOSURES

13. As more fully set forth in the Franke Declaration attached hereto as Exhibit B, Orrick reviewed the list of interested persons and entities included on Schedule 1 to the Franke Declaration (the "Potential Parties in Interest") and searched Orrick's client database for the last three years and Orrick's vendor and insurance carrier databases to determine whether Orrick had, within such period of time, any connections to the Potential Parties in Interest. The Potential Parties in Interest consist of each of the names set forth in the list of parties-in-interest provided to Orrick by the Debtors (the "Debtors' Interested Party List")² and, to the extent identified by Orrick, the names of entities and persons identified in other filings made by the Debtors in these chapter 11 cases. Orrick's conflict search resulted in the disclosures set forth on Schedule 2 to the Franke Declaration. To the best of the Committee's knowledge, information and belief, based on and other than as set forth in the Franke Declaration, Orrick does not have any connection with or represent any interest adverse to the Debtors, their creditors or any other party-in-interest, their attorneys and accountants, the U.S. Trustee or any person employed in the office of the U.S. Trustee, or any judge in the Bankruptcy Court or District Court for the District of Delaware or any person in the offices of the same. The Franke Declaration sets forth, pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 2014(a), to the best of the declarant's knowledge, Orrick's connections with the Debtors, known creditors, other known parties in interest, their respective attorneys and accountants, the U.S. Trustee and any person employed in the office of the U.S. Trustee, and any judge in the Bankruptcy Court or District Court for the District of Delaware and any person in the offices of the same. While

employed by the Committee, Orrick will not represent any entity, other than the Committee, in matters related to these chapter 11 cases.

- 14. The Committee is aware that Orrick is a large firm with a national practice and currently represents or has represented certain of the Potential Parties in Interest in matters unrelated to the chapter 11 cases, as further identified in the Franke Declaration and listed on Schedule 2 thereto. While employed by the Committee, Orrick will not represent any such interested parties in any matter related to these chapter 11 cases. The Committee hereby waives any conflict of interest that exists or may exist due to Orrick's representation of such Potential Parties in Interest in matters unrelated to the Debtors.
- 15. The Committee does not believe that Orrick's representation of any of the Potential Parties in Interest or their affiliate(s) in unrelated matters will impair Orrick's ability to represent the Committee as counsel in connection with these chapter 11 cases. The Committee has been informed that Orrick will conduct ongoing review of its files to ensure that no disqualifying circumstances arise. To the extent that Orrick discovers any connection with any of the Potential Parties in Interest or enters into any new relationship with any of the Potential Parties in Interest, Orrick will promptly supplement its disclosures to the Court.

COMPENSATION OF ORRICK

16. Orrick has agreed to make appropriate applications to this Court for compensation and reimbursement of expenses in compliance with the Bankruptcy Code, the Bankruptcy Rules, the Local Rules and any Order entered by this Court in these chapter 11 cases modifying the timing and/or procedures applicable to the payment of interim compensation and reimbursement of expenses.

17. Orrick has agreed to provide a 10% discount off of its hourly rates for all attorneys and paraprofessionals involved in this representation; *provided*, that the Committee may, in its discretion, elect to waive this discount in connection with Orrick's final fee application. The principal attorneys and paraprofessionals that Orrick anticipates will render services to the Committee and their hourly rates—reflecting the aforementioned discounts—are as follows:

- Orrick's hourly rates are subject to periodic increase in the normal course of Orrick's business. In the event of any such increase, Orrick will provide the U.S. Trustee, the Committee, and the Debtors with written notice of any such increase and file a supplemental affidavit with the Court. Any supplemental affidavit will explain the basis for the requested rate increase in accordance with section 330(a)(3)(F) of the Bankruptcy Code. Pursuant to section B(2)(d) of the U.S. Trustee Guidelines (defined herein), Orrick will provide justification of the reasonableness of any rate increase. Orrick's rates are set at a level designed to fairly compensate Orrick for the work of its attorneys and paraprofessionals and to cover fixed and routine overhead expenses.
- 19. From time to time, other attorneys at Orrick may provide services to the Committee, including certain "project" attorneys on our staff in our Wheeling, WV offices to manage discovery related workstreams and "contract" attorneys to assist with such workstreams

(subject to the terms of the Court's order approving Orrick's retention concerning contract attorneys).

20. Orrick will charge the Committee for all other out-of-pocket expenses and disbursements generally charged to its clients in all areas of practice and in accordance with the Bankruptcy Rules, the Local Rules, the U.S. Trustee Guidelines, and any applicable orders of this Court. The customary expenses charged include, among other things, photocopying charges, filing costs, postage, witness fees, travel expenses, expenses for business meals, computerized research, messengers, couriers, other fees related to trials and hearing (including transcripts), as well as non-ordinary expenses.

STATEMENT REGARDING UNITED STATES TRUSTEE GUIDELINES

- 21. The Committee understands that Orrick intends later in these cases to apply for compensation for professional services rendered and reimbursement of expenses incurred in connection with the Debtors' chapter 11 cases in compliance with sections 330 and 331 of the Bankruptcy Code and applicable provisions of the Bankruptcy Rules, Local Rules, and any other applicable procedures and orders of the Court. The Committee and Orrick will make a reasonable effort to comply with the U.S. Trustee's reasonable requests for information and additional disclosures as set forth in the *Guidelines for Reviewing Applications for Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses Filed Under 11 U.S.C. § 330 by Attorneys in Larger Chapter 11 Cases Effective as of November 1, 2013* (the "U.S. Trustee Guidelines"), both in connection with this Application and the interim and final fee applications to be filed by Orrick.
- 22. As set forth in the Franke Declaration, the following is provided in response to the request for additional information set forth in Paragraph D.1. of the U.S. Trustee Guidelines:

- (a) Orrick has agreed to variations from, or alternatives to, its customary billing arrangements for this engagement. Orrick will provide a 10% discount off of its hourly rates for all attorneys and paraprofessionals involved in this representation; *provided*, that the Committee may, in its discretion, elect to waive this discount in connection with Orrick's final fee application.
- (b) No professional included in this engagement varies their rate based on the geographic location of the bankruptcy cases.
- (c) Orrick has not represented the Committee in the 12 months prepetition and, consequently, there are no billing rates and material financial terms for the prepetition engagement, including any adjustments during the 12 months prepetition to disclose, and Orrick's billing rates and material financial terms have not changed postpetition.
- (d) Orrick expects to develop a budget and staffing plan to reasonably comply with the U.S. Trustee's request for information and additional disclosures, as to which Orrick reserves all rights. The Committee has approved Orrick's proposed hourly billing rates.
- 20. The Committee requests approval of the employment of Orrick as counsel, effective as of August 19, 2025. Such relief is warranted by the circumstances presented by these chapter 11 cases.

NO PRIOR REQUEST

23. No previous request for the relief sought herein has been made to this or any other court.

NOTICE

24. Notice of this Application is being given to: (i) the Office of the U.S. Trustee for the District of Delaware; (ii) the holders of the thirty (30) largest unsecured claims against the Debtors; (iii) Alter Domus (US) LLC, in its capacity as administrative agent and collateral agent

under the Prepetition Financing Agreement and the DIP Facility; (iv) counsel to LiveStyle, Inc.; (v) the Office of the United States Attorney for the District of Delaware; (vi) the Internal Revenue Service; and (vii) any party that has requested notice pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 2002 in these chapter 11 cases. Due to the nature of the relief requested herein, the Committee respectfully submits that no further notice of this Application is necessary.

ORDER PURSUANT TO 11 U.S.C. §§ 328(a) AND 1103(a) AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE EMPLOYMENT AND RETENTION OF ORRICK, HERRINGTON & SUTCLIFFE LLP AS COUNSEL TO THE OFFICIAL COMMITTEE OF UNSECURED CREDITORS, EFFECTIVE AS OF AUGUST 19, 2025

Upon consideration of the application (the "Application")² of the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors (the "Committee"), appointed pursuant to section 1102(a)(1) of chapter 11 of title 11 of the United States Code, 11 U.S.C. §§ 101-1532 (as amended, the "Bankruptcy Code") in the chapter 11 cases of the above-captioned debtors and debtors-in-possession (collectively, the "Debtors"), authorizing and approving the employment and retention of Orrick, Herrington & Sutcliffe LLP ("Orrick") as counsel to the Committee, effective as of August 19, 2025, and upon the Franke Declaration and the Weiss Declaration, as annexed thereto, and it appearing that proper notice of the Application has been given and that no further notice or hearing is required, and the Court being satisfied based on the representations made in the Application and declarations that (i) Orrick represents no interest adverse to the Debtors' estates, creditors, or equity holders, (ii) Orrick is a "disinterested person" as that term is defined in section 101(14) of the Bankruptcy

Code, and (iii) the employment of Orrick is necessary and would be in the best interest of the Committee and the Debtors and their estates, and after due deliberation, and sufficient cause appearing therefor, it is hereby

ORDERED that the Application is granted as set forth herein; and it is further

ORDERED that in accordance with sections 328(a) and 1103(a) of the Bankruptcy Code, the Committee is hereby authorized and empowered to retain Orrick as counsel, effective as of August 19, 2025, to represent the Committee in these cases under chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code, in accordance with the terms set forth in the Application, as modified by this Order; and it is further

ORDERED that Orrick shall be compensated in accordance with the procedures set forth in sections 330 and 331 of the Bankruptcy Code, the Bankruptcy Rules, the Local Rules, and any applicable procedures and orders of the Court; Orrick also intends to make a reasonable effort to comply with the U.S. Trustee's requests for information and additional disclosures as set forth in the *Guidelines for Reviewing Applications for Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses Filed under 11 U.S.C. § 330 by Attorneys in Larger Chapter 11 Cases Effective as of November 1, 2013*, both in connection with the Application and the interim and final fee applications to be filed by Orrick in these chapter 11 cases; and it is further

ORDERED that Orrick will review its files periodically during the pendency of the chapter 11 cases to ensure that no conflicts or other disqualifying circumstances exist or arise and, if any new relevant facts or relationships are discovered or arise, Orrick will use reasonable efforts to identify such furth developments and will promptly file a supplemental declaration, as required by Bankruptcy Rule 2014(a);

ORDERED that Orrick shall use its reasonable efforts to avoid any duplication of services provided by any of the Committee's other retained professionals in these chapter 11 cases; and it is further

ORDERED that, notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the Application or the Franke Declaration, Orrick will not seek reimbursement of expenses for office supplies or secretarial overtime; and it is further

ORDERED that Orrick will not charge a markup to the Committee with respect to fees billed by contract attorneys who are hired by Orrick to provide services to the Committee and shall ensure that any such contract attorneys are subject to conflict checks and disclosures in accordance with the requirements of the Bankruptcy Code and the Bankruptcy Rules. For the avoidance of doubt, Orrick shall not share fees with existing or future contract attorneys who advise the Committee or enter into fee sharing arrangements with such contract attorneys; and it is further

ORDERED that Orrick will provide ten (10) days' advance written notice of any rate increases to the Committee, the U.S. Trustee, and the Debtors before any increases in the rates set forth in the Application or the Franke Declaration are implemented and shall file such notice with the Court; provided, however, that in the event Orrick attorneys responsible for this matter do not have sufficient advance notice of such rate increases, Orrick shall provide notice to the Committee, the U.S. Trustee and the Debtors within three (3) business days after the information regarding rate increases becomes available to the Orrick attorneys responsible for this matter. The Committee, the Debtors, the U.S. Trustee, and all parties-in-interest retain all rights to object to any rate increase on all grounds including, but not limited to, the reasonableness standard provided

for in section 330 of the Bankruptcy Code, and the Court retains the right to review any rate increase pursuant to section 330 of the Bankruptcy Code; and it is further

ORDERED that during the course of these bankruptcy cases, this Court has and shall retain exclusive jurisdiction to hear and determine all matters arising from the implementation of this Order.

DECLARATION OF MARK FRANKE IN SUPPORT OF APPLICATION OF THE OFFICIAL COMMITTEE OF UNSECURED CREDITORS FOR AN ORDER AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE EMPLOYMENT AND RETENTION OF ORRICK, HERRINGTON & SUTCLIFFE LLP AS COUNSEL, EFFECTIVE AS OF AUGUST 19, 2025

Mark Franke, being duly sworn, states the following under penalty of perjury:

- 1. I am an attorney at law admitted to practice in the States of New York and Massachusetts. I am an of counsel at the firm of Orrick, Herrington & Sutcliffe LLP ("Orrick"), which maintains offices at 51 West 52nd Street, New York, New York, as well as in other cities across the world. I am familiar with the matters set forth herein and I am authorized to make this declaration on behalf of Orrick.
- 2. Orrick has agreed to be retained and employed to provide legal services and assistance to the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors (the "Committee") appointed in the chapter 11 cases of the above-captioned debtors and debtors-in-possession (collectively, the "Debtors") and I provide this declaration pursuant to sections 328 and 1103(b) of the Bankruptcy

Code, section 1746 of title 28, United States Code, Bankruptcy Rules 2014(a) and 5002, and Local Rule 2014-1 in support of the Application (the "Application")² of the Committee, seeking approval to employ and Orrick, effective as of August 19, 2025, as counsel to the Committee pursuant to sections 328(a) and 1103(a) of the Bankruptcy Code.

- 3. Orrick has agreed to render the following services, among others, as directed by the Committee and on other matters assigned directly to Orrick by the Committee:
 - Advise the Committee with respect to its rights, powers and duties in these cases;
 - Assist, advise and represent the Committee in analyzing the Debtors' assets and liabilities, including analyzing the claims of the Debtors' creditors and the Debtors' capital structure and negotiating with holders of claims and equity interests;
 - Assist and advise the Committee with regarding to any proposed sale(s) or disposition(s) of the Debtors' assets, including issues concerning any potential competing bidders and the auction process;
 - Attend meetings and negotiate with the representatives of the Debtors;
 - Assist and advise the Committee in its examination and analysis of the conduct of the Debtors' affairs;
 - Assist the Committee in the review, analysis and negotiation of any plan(s) that may be filed and to assist the Committee in the review, analysis and negotiation of the disclosure statements accompanying any plan(s);
 - Investigate and determine the value of unencumbered assets;
 - Analyze and negotiate the budget and monitor the Debtors' financial performance in chapter 11;
 - Assist and advise the Committee with respect to its communications with the general unsecured creditor body regarding significant matters in these cases;

- Review and analyze the work of the Debtors' management and advisors and report to the Committee;
- Provide the Committee with legal advice in relation to the chapter 11 cases;
- Take all necessary action to protect and preserve the interests of unsecured creditors, including, without limitation, the prosecution of actions on its behalf, negotiations concerning all litigation in which the Debtors are involved, and review and analysis of all claims filed against the Debtors' estates;
- Prepare and file on behalf of the Committee all necessary motions, applications, answers, memoranda of law, orders, reports and papers in support of positions taken by the Committee;
- Appear, as appropriate, before this Court, the appellate courts, and other courts in which matters may be heard and to protect the interests of the Committee before said courts and the U.S. Trustee;
- Review and analyze discovery documents provided by the Debtors and other parties in interest in connection with the Committee's investigations;
- Perform such other legal services in these cases as may be required and are deemed to be in the interests of the Committee and unsecured creditors in accordance with the Committee's powers and duties as set forth in the Bankruptcy Code; and
- Advise and assist with respect to other matters as the Committee may request from time to time, in each case without duplication of the services of Morris James or any other Committee professional.
- 4. In performance of such duties, Orrick shall report to the Committee.
- 5. Orrick's retention by the Committee is necessary because Orrick has recognized expertise and extensive experience and knowledge in the field of business reorganizations and liquidations under the Bankruptcy Code and insolvency and commercial law and is well qualified to undertake the responsibilities as counsel to the Committee.
- 6. By separate application, the Committee will request that the Court approve the retention and employment of Morris James as Delaware co-counsel. Orrick intends to work closely

with the representatives of the Debtors and the other professionals retained by the Committee, including Morris James, to ensure that there is no unnecessary duplication of services performed or charged to the Debtors' estates.

- 7. In connection with its proposed employment by the Committee in these chapter 11 cases, an attorney working under my supervision reviewed the list of interested persons and entities included on Schedule 1 attached hereto (the "Potential Parties in Interest") and searched Orrick's client database for the last three years and Orrick's vendor and insurance carrier databases to determine whether Orrick had, within such period of time, any connections to the Potential Parties in Interest. The Potential Parties in Interest consist of each of the names set forth in the list of parties-in-interest provided to Orrick by the Debtors (the "Debtors' Interested Party List")³ and, to the extent identified by Orrick, the names of entities and persons identified in other filings made by the Debtors in these chapter 11 cases. Orrick's conflict search resulted in the disclosures set forth on Schedule 2 attached hereto.
- 8. Based upon information currently available to me, Orrick has no connection with the Debtors, their creditors, or any other party in interest, their attorneys and accountants, the U.S. Trustee or any person employed in the office of the U.S. Trustee, or any judge in the Bankruptcy Court or District Court for the District of Delaware or any person in the offices of the same, except as set forth on Schedule 2 attached hereto.
- 9. From time to time, Orrick works with certain law firms (including Morris James) and other professional firms that have been retained by or are proposed to be retained by the

Committee, the Debtors or other parties in these cases and that may be rendering advice to other parties in interest in these chapter 11 cases.

- 10. The Debtors have numerous relationships and creditors. Consequently, although every reasonable effort has been made to discover and eliminate the possibility of any connection or conflict, including the efforts outlined above, Orrick is unable to state with certainty whether any more of its clients or such clients' affiliated entities hold claims or otherwise are parties in interest in these chapter 11 cases. If Orrick discovers any information that is contrary to or pertinent to the statements made herein, Orrick will promptly disclose such information to the Court on notice to the creditors and the U.S. Trustee.
- 11. To the best of my knowledge and information, and except as set forth herein, Orrick does not have any connection with the Debtors or any other significant party-in-interest and does not hold or represent any interest adverse to the estates, and I believe that Orrick is a "disinterested person" within the meaning of section 101(14) of the Bankruptcy Code.
- 12. The Committee is aware that Orrick is a large firm with a national practice and currently represents or has represented certain of the Potential Parties in Interest in matters unrelated to the chapter 11 cases, as further identified herein and listed on <u>Schedule 2</u> hereto. While employed by the Committee, Orrick will not represent any such interested parties in any matter related to these chapter 11 cases.
- 13. After the chapter 11 cases were commenced but before the Committee was formed, Orrick spoke and corresponded with attorneys representing plaintiffs in the class action lawsuit against certain of the Debtors related to the 2023 Electric Zoo festival whose clients include Committee member Lauren Bair. Further, Orrick spoke to and corresponded with a professional

acquaintance (whom I have known since July 2025 through our respective work on another chapter 11 case) who was assisting plaintiff's counsel in that class action before and after Committee formation. In addition, Orrick was introduced to a representative from Committee member Gateway Productions, Inc. by another one of the Debtors' vendors and spoke to and corresponded with such representative before and after Committee formation. Orrick also spoke to and corresponded with counsel for Committee member Nova Traffic AG after Committee formation. Finally, Orrick exchanged limited correspondence with counsel for Committee member Heini Limited Liability Company following formation of the Committee. In at least the first communication with each of such representatives of Committee members, Orrick informed such representatives that Orrick intended to pitch the Committee if asked to do so. Orrick was asked to pitch the Committee on August 19, 2025, and Orrick did so. Following that presentation and the presentations of competing law firms seeking to be retained by the Committee, Orrick was selected as counsel for the Committee.

- 14. Orrick will promptly file with the Court a supplemental declaration if and when any further connections between it and such Potential Parties in Interest are discovered.
- 15. To the best of my knowledge, and except as set forth herein, neither Orrick nor any attorney at the firm: (a) holds or represents an interest adverse to the Debtors' estates; (b) is or was a creditor, an equity security holder or an insider of the Debtors; (c) is or was, within two years before the Petition Date, a director, officer, or employee of the Debtors; or (d) has an interest materially adverse to the interests of the estates or of any class of creditors or equity security holders, by reason of any direct or indirect relationship to, connection with, or interest in the

Debtors, or for any other reason. Orrick avers that none of its connections to the Potential Parties in Interest disclosed herein are disqualifying.

- 16. Due to the size and diversity of its practice, Orrick may have represented or otherwise dealt with, and may now be representing or otherwise dealing with, various persons (and their attorneys and accountants) who are or may consider themselves creditors, equity security holders or parties-in-interest in these cases but who are not presently identified as Potential Parties in Interest. However, such representation or involvement, if any, does not relate to the Debtors or their estates.
- 17. In addition to the foregoing, Orrick's partners and employees may have business associations with, professional, social, or familial relationships with, or interests aligned with or adverse to, creditors or parties in interest, or their attorneys, accountants, or advisors. As part of its practice, Orrick appears in cases, proceedings, and transactions throughout the world involving many different parties, and works together with many different parties, which may include creditors or parties in interest, or attorneys, accountants, or other professional firms or advisors who may represent creditors or parties in interest in these cases. To the best of my knowledge, none of these associations, relationships, or interests have any connection with the Debtors, the Committee, or these chapter 11 cases.
- 18. In addition, to the best of my knowledge, information, and belief and in accordance with Bankruptcy Rule 5002, neither I, nor any attorney at Orrick is a relative of any of the United States Bankruptcy Judges for the District of Delaware that may be assigned to these cases or the U.S. Trustee, and Orrick does not have a connection with any United States Bankruptcy Judge for the District of Delaware or the U.S. Trustee that would render its retention in these cases improper.

- 19. Orrick will conduct an ongoing review of its files to ensure that no disqualifying circumstances arise. To the extent that Orrick discovers any connection with any of the Potential Parties in Interest or enters into any new relationship with any of the Potential Parties in Interest, Orrick will promptly supplement its disclosures to the Court.
- 20. Orrick has not received a retainer or compensation in connection with its proposed representation of the Committee in the chapter 11 cases.
- 21. No agreement exists, nor will any be made, to share any compensation received by Orrick for its services with any other person or firm other than to share this compensation among its partners, associates, and employees.
- 22. Orrick has agreed to provide a 10% discount off of its hourly rates for all attorneys and paraprofessionals involved in this representation; *provided*, that the Committee may, in its discretion, elect to waive this discount in connection with Orrick's final fee application. The principal attorneys and paraprofessionals that Orrick anticipates will render services to the Committee and their hourly rates—reflecting the aforementioned discounts—are as follows:

24. Orrick's hourly rates are subject to periodic increase in the normal course of Orrick's business. In the event of any such increase, Orrick will provide the U.S. Trustee, the

Committee, and the Debtors with written notice of any such increase and file a supplemental affidavit with the Court. Any supplemental affidavit will explain the basis for the requested rate increase in accordance with section 330(a)(3)(F) of the Bankruptcy Code. Pursuant to section B(2)(d) of the U.S. Trustee Guidelines (defined herein), Orrick will provide justification of the reasonableness of any rate increase. From time to time, other attorneys at Orrick may provide services to the Committee. Orrick's rates are set at a level designed to fairly compensate Orrick for the work of its attorneys and paraprofessionals and to cover fixed and routine overhead expenses.

- 25. From time to time, other attorneys at Orrick may provide services to the Committee, including certain "project" attorneys on our staff in our Wheeling, WV offices to manage discovery related workstreams and "contract" attorneys to assist with such workstreams (subject to the terms of the Court's order approving Orrick's retention concerning contract attorneys).
- 26. Orrick will charge the Committee for all other out-of-pocket expenses and disbursements generally charged to its clients in all areas of practice and in accordance with the Bankruptcy Rules, the Local Rules, the U.S. Trustee Guidelines, and any applicable orders of this Court. The customary expenses charged include, among other things, photocopying charges, filing costs, postage, witness fees, travel expenses, expenses for business meals, computerized research, messengers, couriers, other fees related to trials and hearing (including transcripts), as well as non-ordinary expenses.
- 27. Orrick is willing to be employed by the Committee as its counsel under the terms as set forth in the Application and will make appropriate application to this Court for compensation and reimbursement of out-of-pocket expenses, all in accordance with the provisions of the

Bankruptcy Code, the Bankruptcy Rules, the Local Rules and any orders of the Court entered in these chapter 11 cases. The Committee and Orrick will make a reasonable effort to comply with the U.S. Trustee's requests for information and additional disclosures as set forth in the *Guidelines for Reviewing Applications for Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses Filed under 11 U.S.C. § 330 by Attorneys in Larger Chapter 11 Cases Effective as of November 1, 2013* (the "U.S. Trustee Guidelines"), both in connection with the Application and the interim and final fee applications to be filed by Orrick in these chapter 11 cases.

- 28. The following is provided in response to the request for additional information set forth in Paragraph D.1. of the U.S. Trustee Guidelines:
- (a) Orrick has agreed to variations from, or alternatives to, its customary billing arrangements for this engagement. Orrick will provide a 10% discount off of its hourly rates for all attorneys and paraprofessionals involved in this representation; *provided*, that the Committee may, in its discretion, elect to waive this discount in connection with Orrick's final fee application.
- (b) No professional included in this engagement varies their rate based on the geographic location of the bankruptcy cases.
- (c) Orrick has not represented the Committee in the 12 months prepetition and, consequently, there are no billing rates and material financial terms for the prepetition engagement, including any adjustments during the 12 months prepetition to disclose, and Orrick's billing rates and material financial terms have not changed postpetition.
- (d) Orrick expects to develop a budget and staffing plan to reasonably comply with the U.S. Trustee's request for information and additional disclosures, as to which Orrick reserves all rights. The Committee has approved Orrick's proposed hourly billing rates.

DECLARATION OF KELLY WEISS IN SUPPORT OF APPLICATION OF THE OFFICIAL COMMITTEE OF UNSECURED CREDITORS FOR AN ORDER AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE EMPLOYMENT AND RETENTION OF ORRICK, HERRINGTON & SUTCLIFFE LLP AS COUNSEL, EFFECTIVE AS OF AUGUST 19, 2025

- I, Kelly Weiss, hereby declare that the following is true to the best of my knowledge, information, and belief:
- 1. I am over the age of 21 and I am a Senior Vice President at Wasserman and representative of Aaron Clevenger. I am competent in all respects to make this declaration and serve as Co-Chairperson of the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors (the "Committee") appointed in the chapter 11 cases of the above-captioned debtors and debtors-in-possession (collectively, the "Debtors").
- 2. I submit this declaration in support of the Application of the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors for Entry of an Order Authorizing and Approving the Employment and Retention of Orrick, Herrington & Sutcliffe LLP as Counsel, Effective as of August 19, 2025 (the

"Application"),² filed contemporaneously herewith by the Committee to retain Orrick as its counsel. Unless otherwise stated in this declaration, I have personal knowledge of the facts set forth herein and, if called as a witness, would testify competently thereto.

- 3. This declaration is provided pursuant to the *Guidelines for Reviewing Applications* for Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses Filed Under 11 U.S.C. § 330 by Attorneys in Larger Chapter 11 Cases Effective as of November 1, 2013 (the "U.S. Trustee Guidelines"). I am informed by Orrick that Paragraph D.2 of the U.S. Trustee Guidelines requires that any application for employment of an attorney under sections 327 or 1103 of the Bankruptcy Code be accompanied by a verified statement from the proposed client that addresses the following:
 - a. The identity and position of the person making the verification.
 - b. The steps taken by the client to ensure that the applicant's billing rates and material terms for the engagement are comparable to the applicant's billing rates and terms for other non-bankruptcy engagements and to the billing rates and terms of other comparably skilled professionals.
 - c. The number of firms the client interviewed.
 - d. If the billing rates are not comparable to the applicant's billing rates for other non-bankruptcy engagements and to the billing rates of other comparably skilled professionals, the circumstances warranting the retention of that firm.
 - e. The procedures the client has established to supervise the applicant's fees and expenses and to manage costs. If the procedures for the budgeting, review and approval of fees and expenses differ from those the client regularly employs in non-bankruptcy cases to supervise outside counsel, explain how and why. In addition, describe any efforts to negotiate rates, including rates for routine matters, or in the alternative to delegate such matters to less expensive counsel.
- 4. On August 18, 2025, the U.S. Trustee appointed the Committee to represent the interests of general unsecured creditors of the Debtors. The Committee currently consists of seven

members. As a representative of a member and Co-Chairperson of the Committee, I was directly involved with the Committee's selection process for counsel in these chapter 11 cases.

5. On August 19, 2025, the Committee participated in a series of interviews during which several law firms presented their qualifications as potential counsel to the Committee. Ultimately, on August 19, 2025, the Committee selected Orrick as its counsel because of the firm's expertise and experience in the field of business reorganizations and liquidations under the Bankruptcy Code and insolvency and commercial law, and, shortly thereafter, selected Morris James as Delaware co-counsel. At the request of the Committee, Orrick commenced providing legal services immediately.

BILLING RATE STRUCTURE

- 6. Orrick has informed the Committee that its rates for bankruptcy representations are the same as its rates for similar non-bankruptcy representations. The hourly rates charged by Orrick attorneys vary with the experience and seniority of the individuals assigned and not as a function of whether the services performed relate to a bankruptcy engagement or a non-bankruptcy engagement. Orrick also has informed the Committee that it endeavors to set hourly rates for its attorneys and paraprofessionals at levels competitive to those charged by comparably skilled professionals in other law firms.
- 7. The members of the Committee reviewed Orrick's discounted hourly rates for this matter as set forth in the Application. Based upon Orrick's representations to the Committee, I understand that those rates are generally comparable to, or less than, Orrick's hourly rates for bankruptcy and non-bankruptcy engagements and the billing rates and terms of other comparably-

skilled firms for providing similar services. Based upon these representations, the Committee believes that these rates are reasonable.

COST SUPERVISION

- 8. Throughout these chapter 11 cases, the Committee will supervise Orrick's fees and expenses to manage costs. In particular, the Committee will review Orrick's invoices and monthly applications for payment of fees and reimbursement of expenses. The Committee understands that the hourly rates of Orrick's attorneys and paraprofessionals are subject to annual increases, in the normal course of the firm's business.
- 9. The Committee and its counsel expect to develop a prospective budget and staffing plan, recognizing that in the course of large cases like these chapter 11 cases, complex and unexpected issues may arise that may in turn result in unforeseeable fees and expenses. The Committee will continue to review the invoices that Orrick regularly submits and, together with Orrick, may amend the budget and staffing plans periodically, as necessary throughout the course of these chapter 11 cases.
- 10. Nothing contained in this declaration is intended to either limit Orrick's ability to request allowance and payment of fees and expenses pursuant to sections 330 and 331 of the Bankruptcy Code, or to restrict Orrick's right to defend against any objection with respect to the allowance or payment of such fees or retain conflicts counsel to prosecute any such fee objection to the extent it is not resolved informally by the parties or raised by another party in interest, such as the U.S. Trustee.
- 11. Based on the foregoing, the Committee is of the opinion that it is necessary to employ Orrick and that such employment is in the best interest of the Debtors' estates.

Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746, I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
