#### SUPPLEMENT TO FIRST INTERIM FEE APPLICATION OF YOUNG CONAWAY STARGATT & TAYLOR, LLP

Young Conaway Stargatt & Taylor, LLP ("Young Conaway"), counsel to the above-captioned debtors and debtors in possession (collectively, the "Debtors"), hereby submits this supplement to the First Interim Fee Application of Young Conaway Stargatt & Taylor, LLP [D.I. 417] (the "First Interim Application") for the period from August 4, 2025 through October 31, 2025 (the "Application Period") by attaching, as **Exhibits A** through **E** hereto, certain schedules requested by the Appendix B Guidelines for Reviewing Applications for Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses Filed Under United States Code by Attorneys in Larger Chapter 11 Cases (the "UST Guidelines"). In addition, Young Conaway respectfully states as follows to address the questions set forth under section C.5 of the UST Guidelines:

- During the Application Period, Young Conaway did not agree to any a. variations from, or alternatives to, its standard or customary billing rates, fees, or terms.
- The fees sought by Young Conaway in the First Interim Application are b. more than 10% higher than the fees budgeted in the budget provided by Young Conaway to the Debtors for the Application Period. Young Conaway has discussed the higher fees with the Debtors, who approve.

- c. The professionals included in the First Interim Application did not vary their hourly rate based on the geographic location of the bankruptcy cases.
- d. The First Interim Application did not include any fees dedicated to revising time records or preparing and revising invoices that would not normally be compensable outside of bankruptcy.
- e. The time period covered by the First Interim Application includes approximately 12.20 hours with a value of \$13,115.00 spent by Young Conaway to ensure that the time entries subject to the First Interim Application comply with the Local Rules of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware and do not disclose privileged or confidential information. This review and any revisions associated therewith are a necessary component of Young Conaway's preparation of each monthly fee application.
- f. The First Interim Application does not include any rate increases since Young Conaway's retention.
