ORDERED that Judge Horan is being appointed because of his judicial position as, and to act in the specific capacity as, a



United States Bankruptcy Judge. By serving as the Settlement Judge herein, Judge Horan will be performing judicial duties.¹ As such, Judge Horan and all persons assisting him as the Settlement Judge will have full, unqualified judicial immunity, as well as all other privileges, immunities, and protections of a United States Bankruptcy Judge and judiciary employees, regarding any matters arising from or related to Judge Horan's role as the Settlement Judge; and it is further

ORDERED that the parties shall communicate directly with Judge Horan's chambers regarding procedures for, and scheduling of, the settlement conference.
