**CERTIFICATION OF COUNSEL REGARDING
CONFIDENTIALITY AGREEMENT AND STIPULATED PROTECTIVE ORDER**

The undersigned special counsel to AN Global LLC, and its affiliated debtors and debtors in possession (collectively, the “Debtors”), hereby certifies the following:

1. On August 28, August 29, September 1, October 6, and December 28, 2023, the Debtors filed voluntary petitions for relief under Chapter 11 of the United States Bankruptcy Code in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware (the “Court”).

2. No trustee or examiner has been appointed in these Chapter 11 Cases. On September 7, 2023, the Office of the United States Trustee (the “U.S. Trustee”) appointed an Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors. *See* Docket No. 88.

3. The Debtors and counsel for KPMG LLP (“KPMG” and with the Debtors, the “Parties”) have entered into a Confidentiality Agreement and Stipulated Protective Order (the
