PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that Luis Salazar, in his capacity as Consumer Privacy Ombudsman (the "Consumer Privacy Ombudsman") has filed his First and Final Application for Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses of Luis Salazar, Esq., Consumer Privacy Ombudsman for the Period of April 22, 2025 through July 16, 2025 (the "Application") and related papers with the Court seeking an order (i) allowing, and awarding, on a final basis, fees in the amount of \$15,275.00 for the period of April 22, 2025 through and including July 16, 2025 and \$258.60 for reimbursement of expenses, for a total amount of \$15,333.60; (iii) authorizing direct and immediate payment of \$15,333.60 for the period of April 22, 2025 through and including July 16, 2025.

Pursuant to Third Amended and Restated General Order No. 24-2018, the Court may consider this matter without further notice or a hearing if no party in interest files a response or objection within twenty-one (21) days from the date of service of this notice. If you object to the relief requested in the Application, you must timely file your objection with the Bankruptcy Clerk at the United States Courthouse, U. S. Bankruptcy Court, 18 Greenville Street, 2nd Floor, Newnan, Georgia 30263, and serve a copy on the Consumer Privacy Ombudsman at 2121 SW 3rd Avenue, Suite 200, Miami, Florida 33129, and any other appropriate persons by the objection deadline. The response or objection must explain your position and be actually received by the Bankruptcy Clerk within the required time.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that a hearing on the Application has been scheduled. The Court will hold a hearing on the Application at 1:30 p.m. on September 30, 2025 in Courtroom 1202, at the United States Courthouse, 75 Ted Turner Drive, SW, Atlanta, Georgia 30303, which may be attended in person or via the Court's Virtual Hearing Room. You may join the Virtual Hearing Room through the "Dial-In and Virtual Bankruptcy Hearing Information" link at the top of the homepage of the Court's website,

You should be prepared to appear at the hearing via video, but you may leave your camera in the off position until the Court instructs otherwise. Unrepresented persons who do not have video capability may use the telephone dial-in information on the judge's webpage.

If an objection or response is timely filed and served, the hearing will proceed as scheduled. If you do not file a response or objection within the time permitted, the Court may grant the relief requested without further notice and without holding the scheduled hearing provided that an order approving the relief requested is entered at least one business day prior to the scheduled hearing. If no objection is timely filed, but no order is entered granting the relief requested at least one business day prior to the scheduled hearing, the hearing will be held as scheduled.

Your rights may be affected. You should read these papers carefully and discuss them with your attorney, if you have one in this bankruptcy case. If you do not have an attorney, you may wish to consult one.
