Committee having demonstrated upon the record herein good cause for the relief requested in the Motion; and after due deliberation

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The Motion is GRANTED.
2. The Confidential Information (as defined in the Motion) contained in and/or attached to the *Supplement To Opposition Of The Official Committee Of Asbestos Personal Injury Claimants To Debtors' Motion For Partial Summary Judgment That All Actions Against The Protected Parties To Recover Aldrich/Murray Asbestos Claims Are Automatically Stayed By Section 362 Of The Bankruptcy Code* [Adv. Dkt. No. 180] (the “**SJ Opposition Supplemental Brief**”) are to remain filed on the public docket in a redacted format.
3. The references in the SJ Opposition Supplemental Brief to the Confidential Information are to be redacted from the version of the SJ Opposition Supplemental Brief filed on the public docket.
4. This Court shall retain jurisdiction with respect to all matters relating to the interpretation or implementation of this Order.
