ORDER SHORTENING NOTICE

THIS CAUSE coming on to be heard before the undersigned United States Bankruptcy Judge upon the *Ex Parte* Motion for Order Shortening Notice (the “Motion to Shorten Notice”) in respect of a hearing on Motion of Debtors and Non-Debtor Affiliates for Order (A) Authorizing the Debtors to Enter into Tolling Agreement and (B) Staying Litigation (the “Motion”), and the Court, having reviewed the pleadings and the Court’s file and for good cause shown, it is hereby ORDERED:

- A. That the Motion to Shorten Notice is GRANTED; and
- B. That the hearing on the Motion shall occur on March 31, 2022, at 9:30 a.m. EDT or as soon thereafter as the Court is able to hear the matter, in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of North Carolina, 401 West Trade Street, Charlotte, North Carolina 28202.
- C. That the deadline to respond to the Motion shall be March 25, 2022.
- D. That the deadline to reply to any objections to the Motion shall be March 29, 2022.
