1); and *Non-Party Certain Matching Claimants' Reply in Support of the Motion to Proceed Anonymously* (Dkt. 5-7), for the reasons set forth in the Court's bench ruling on February 14, 2023 (which bench ruling is incorporated herein by reference), the Court hereby FINDS, ORDERS, ADJUDGES, AND DECREES that:

1. The Motion is DENIED, and Movants must identify themselves by full name.
2. The requirement that any Movants identify themselves shall be stayed until the 31st day following entry of this Order to permit such Movants (if desired) to seek a stay pending appeal from the district court. Movants are hereby relieved of any obligation to seek a stay from this Court before seeking a stay in the district court.
3. This Court shall retain exclusive jurisdiction over this Order and any and all matters arising from or relating to the implementation, interpretation, or enforcement of this Order.
