### **ORDER DENYING EX PARTE MOTION TO AMEND SCHEDULING ORDER**

**THIS MATTER** is before the Court on the Ex Parte Motion to Amend Scheduling Order (the “Motion”) filed by the Verus Parties and the DCPF Parties on May 11, 2023. The Motion requests that the deadline for the Objecting Parties to file briefs in support of sampling be extended to May 22, 2023, and that the Debtor’s deadline to file a reply brief be extended to June 2, 2023. The Court has reviewed the Motion and the Debtor’s Opposition to Objectors Ex Parte Motion to Amend Scheduling Order and believes that the Motion should be **DENIED**. The deadlines previously established in the May 3, 2023 Order Scheduling Rehearing Motion For June 6, 2023, And Setting Related Briefing Schedule shall remain unchanged.<sup>1</sup>
