
(b) Florida Power & Light Company, Georgia Power Company and Tampa Electric Company hold surety bonds that they will make claims upon for payment of the prepetition debt that the Debtors owe to those Utilities.

(c) For more information regarding the claims and interests of the Utilities in these jointly-administered cases, refer to the (i) *Objection of Certain Utility Companies To the Motion of Debtors For Entry of Interim and Final Orders (I) Determining Adequate Assurance of Payment For Future Utility Services, (II) Prohibiting Utility Providers From Altering, Refusing, or Discontinuing Services, (III) Approving Debtors' Proposed Procedures For Resolving Adequate Assurance Requests, and (IV) Granting Related Relief* (the "Objection") (Docket No. 177), and (ii) *Joinder of Certain FirstEnergy Operating Companies* (the "Joinder") (Docket No. 178) to the Objection, filed in the above-captioned, jointly-administered, bankruptcy

cases.
