The Court heard from Counsel regarding the current status of matters to be heard on June 13, 2019. Counsel indicated they have shared exhibits/witness lists, and believe the matter will be done in one day. Mr. Maizel on behalf of Debtor requested the opportunity to allow the filed declarations of their witnesses to serve as their direct testimony but be available for cross-examination and rebuttal if necessary. No objections were raised to that, and the Court will allow that procedure. Mr. Sherman on behalf of the Unsecured Creditors Committee requested that they be allowed to see any agreed set of facts Debtor, UMB and Lapis have reached prior to the hearing. Mr. Dyer on behalf of the United States Trustee indicated his objection regarding the motion to redact is set for hearing that day, and if the motion is granted, Trustee and Debtor have language worked out. That motion will be heard first. He also indicated there are some housekeeping matters that if not resolved he will bring before the Court.
