Factual basis:

I wish to file my opposition to the above referenced *Third Omnibus Claims Objection* for late filed claims. My claim in the about of \$9,231.60 was secondary to the loss of Personal Time Off (PTO) that was accrued after Astria's initial bankruptcy filing on May 6, 2019. As the Chief Nursing Officer and Chief Quality Officer of Astria Regional Medical Center, I did not have the opportunity to take any time off in the ensuing months between the bankruptcy filing and the hospital's closure. As a nurse, I felt a duty and obligation to work with the clinical staff and ensure quality patient care during a time of considerable disruption, waning morale, and slowly vacating personnel. I am proud of the work that Regional's nursing and medical staff provided – missteps and safety issues were averted. I worked an additional month post-closing to ensure an appropriate inventory of assets, particularly of clinical and surgical equipment.

My \$9,231.60 filing represents 120 PTO hours accrued post-bankruptcy filing at \$76.93/hour rate of pay. As such, I am filing my opposition to the above named objection disallowing my claim.
