Dear John:

This agreement sets forth the terms and conditions regarding your separation from employment from IEH Auto Parts LLC (the "Company") effective April 22, 2023 (the "Separation Date").

The terms and conditions set forth in paragraphs 1, 2, and the first sentence of paragraph 5 below will apply regardless of whether you decide to sign this letter agreement. However, you will not be eligible to receive the payment set forth in paragraph 3 below unless you sign and do not revoke this letter agreement. See paragraph 13 below for what it means to revoke this letter agreement.

1. Your last day of employment is April 22, 2023. You will receive your regular pay as a full-time employee according to the Company's regular payroll practices through the Separation Date. To the extent that you have accrued, unused Paid Time Off ("PTO"), you also will receive a payment (less applicable taxes and payroll withholdings) for any hours of accrued, unused PTO, according to the Company's records as of the Separation Date (less any PTO you use between the date of this letter and the Separation Date).
2. Because of your separation from employment, your eligibility for and coverage under the Company's employee benefit plans will end on April 30, 2023, which is the last day of the month of separation.
3. In addition to the above payments, the Company is offering you the opportunity to receive severance total payment in the amount of ~~\$6,800.00~~ less applicable taxes and payroll withholdings to be paid in equal installments on your regular pay schedule over the number of weeks of severance pay to which you are entitled according to the IEH Auto Parts LLC Severance Plan dated September 1, 2022. Pursuant to the Company's Chapter 11 filing on January 31, 2023 and section 507(a)(4) of the Bankruptcy Code, the Company is only authorized to pay ~~\$15,150.00~~ less applicable taxes and payroll withholdings, at this time. Should you seek to obtain any amount of your severance payment beyond the first ~~\$15,150.00~~, you need to file a claim in the bankruptcy case. By signing below, you understand that full recovery of the claim may not be possible. Notwithstanding any other provision hereof, as a condition to the Company's payment to you of the amounts in this paragraph 3, you shall be required to execute, return to the Company, and not revoke within the Revocation Period (as defined in paragraph 13), this letter agreement agreeing to its terms, including the general release of claims contained in paragraph 7(a). These payments will begin within 15 working days after the Effective Date of this letter agreement (as defined below in paragraph 13).
