### **Statement of Claim**

Aerovias Del Continente Americano Avianca S.A<u>.</u> and its affiliates (collectively, the "**Debtors**") are liable to Adobe Systems Software Ireland LTD (the "**Creditor**"), in the amount of not less than \$28,400.00 (the "**Claim**"), for amounts payable with respect to the terms of that certain Master Agreement effective as of July 31, 2017 (the "**Adobe Contract**"). A copy of the Adobe Contract is not attached hereto due to the confidentiality provisions contained within the Adobe Contract but a copy will be made available to the Debtor upon request.

To date, no notice that the Adobe Contract has been rejected pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §365, or otherwise terminated has been served on Creditor and, accordingly, Creditor asserts that the Debtor is obligated to make all payments that become due and owing pursuant to the Contract according to the terms of the Contract.

Further, Creditor represents that additional amounts may accrue from and after May 10, 2020 (the "Petition Date") through the end of the term of the Adobe Contract and all such amounts, subject to 11 U.S.C. §503(b), constitute administrative expenses and, therefore, all such amounts are entitled to priority in payment as permitted by 11 U.S.C. §507.
