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**SUPPLEMENTAL CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE**

1. I, Heather Fellows, depose and say that I am employed by Kurtzman Carson Consultants LLC (“KCC”), the claims and noticing agent for the Debtors in the above-captioned case. I submit this Supplemental Certificate in connection with the service of solicitation materials for the *Amended Joint Chapter 11 Plan of Briggs & Stratton Corporation and Its Affiliated Debtors* (the “**Plan**”). I am over the age of 18 and not a party to this action. Except as otherwise noted, I could and would testify to the following based upon my personal knowledge.

2. On August 20, 2020, the Court entered the *Final Order Authorizing Retention and Appointment of Kurtzman Carson Consultants, LLC as Claims and Noticing Agent and Administrative Advisor* [Docket No. 531].

3. Consistent with its retention as claims and noticing agent and administrative advisor, KCC is charged with, among other things, the duty of printing and distributing Solicitation Packages<sup>1</sup> to creditors and other interested parties pursuant to the solicitation and voting procedures included in the Motion of Debtors for Entry of Order (I) Approving Disclosure Statement; (II) Establishing Notice and Objection Procedures for Confirmation of Plan; (III) Approving Solicitation Packages and Procedures for Distribution Thereof; (IV) Approving Form of Ballots and Establishing Procedures for Voting on Plan; and (V) Granting Related Relief [Docket No. 1070] (the “**Disclosure Statement Motion**”) filed by the Debtors on October 10, 2020 and the *Order (I) Approving Disclosure Statement; (II) Establishing Notice and Objection Procedures for Confirmation of Plan; (III) Approving Solicitation Packages and Procedures for Distribution Thereof; (IV) Approving the Form of Ballots and Establishing Procedures for Voting on the Plan; and (V) Granting Related Relief* [Docket No. 1233] (the “**Disclosure Statement Order**”) which the Court entered on November 10, 2020.

4. The Solicitation Packages consists of the following materials (the “**Solicitation Packages**”):

- i. Notice of (I) Order Approving Disclosure Statement; (II) Hearing on Confirmation of Plan; (III) Procedures and Deadline for Objecting to

Confirmation of the Plan; and (IV) Procedures and Deadline for Voting on the Plan (the “**Confirmation Hearing Notice**”) (substantially in the form attached as Exhibit B to the Disclosure Statement Order);

- b. with respect to holders of Claims in the Voting Classes, Classes 4(a), 4(b), 4(c), 4(d), and 4(e) – General Unsecured Claims against each Debtor, which Classes are impaired and entitled to vote on the Plan:
  - i. if applicable, a flash drive (the “**Flash Drive**”) containing the following documents:
    1. the Amended Disclosure Statement for Joint Chapter 11 Plan of Briggs & Stratton Corporation and Its Affiliated Debtors (the “**Disclosure Statement**”);
    2. the Plan;
    3. the Disclosure Statement Order (without Exhibits);
  - ii. a customized copy of the appropriate customized Ballot(s) and voting instructions for the voting class in which the creditor is entitled to vote (with a pre-addressed, postage prepaid return envelope, if applicable (the “Return Envelope”):
    1. Ballot for Classes 4(a), 4(b), 4(c), 4(d), 4(e) - General Unsecured Claims (the “**Class 4 Ballot**”) (substantially in the form attached as Exhibit C-1 to the Disclosure Statement Order);
    2. Master Ballot for Class 4 Unsecured Notes Claims (the “**Class 4 Master Ballot**”) (substantially in the form attached as Exhibit C-2 to the Disclosure Statement Order);
    3. Beneficial Holder Ballot for Class 4 Unsecured Notes Claims (the “**Class 4 Beneficial Holder Ballot**”) (substantially in the form attached as Exhibit C-3 to the Disclosure Statement Order);
- c. with respect to holders of Claims or Interests in Classes 1(a) through 1(e) – Priority Tax Claims Against Each Debtor, Class 2(a) through 2(e) - Priority Non-Tax Claims against each Debtor, and Classes 3(a) through 3(e) – Other Secured Claims against each Debtor, which Classes are unimpaired, presumed to accept the Plan, and not entitled to vote on the Plan:
  - i. the Notice of Non-Voting Status to Unimpaired Classes (the “**Unimpaired Non-Voting Status Notice**”) (substantially in the form attached as Exhibit D to the Disclosure Statement Order);
- d. With respect to holders of Claims or Interests in Classes 5(a) through 5(e) – Subordinated Securities Claims Against Each Debtor, and Class 7(a) – Equity Interests in BSC, that are impaired, deemed to reject the Plan, and not entitled to vote on the Plan:

- i. the Notice of Non-Voting Status to Impaired Classes 5(a)-5(e) (the “**Impaired Class 5 Non-Voting Status Notice**”) (substantially in the form attached as Exhibit E to the Disclosure Statement Order);
- ii. the Notice of Non-Voting Status to Impaired Class 7(a) and Opt-Out Election Form (the “**Impaired Class 7(a) Non-Voting Status Notice**”) (substantially in the form attached as Exhibit F and F-1 to the Disclosure Statement Order);
- iii. the Opt-Out Election Form (Master Ballot) (the “**Class 7(a) Master Ballot Opt-Out Election Form**”) (substantially in the form attached as Exhibit F-2 to the Disclosure Statement Order);
- iv. the Notice of Non-Voting Status to Impaired Class 7(a) and Opt-Out Election Form (Beneficial Holder) (the “**Impaired Class 7(a) Non-Voting Status Notice and Beneficial Holder Opt-Out Election Form**”) (substantially in the form attached as Exhibit F and Exhibit F-3 to the Disclosure Statement Order);
