PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that audio communication will be by use of the Court’s dial-in facility. You may access the facility at (832) 917-1510. You will be responsible for your own long-distance charges. Once connected, you will be asked to enter the conference room number. Judge Isgur’s conference room number is 954554.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that you may view video via GoToMeeting. To use GoToMeeting, the Court recommends that you download the free GoToMeeting application. To connect, you should enter the meeting code “JudgeIsgur” in the GoToMeeting application or click the link on Judge Isgur’s home page on the Southern District of Texas website. Once
