If the litigation is unsuccessful, these expenses may not be reimbursed and there may be little or no additional recovery for the Estate and its creditors.

The above available funds are subject to the continuing administration of the Estates, pending and future litigation, and professional expenses incurred by the Plan Administrator in furtherance of its duties. The Plan Administrator also intends to move the Bankruptcy Court for approval of substantial additional compensation pursuant to the terms of the Plan Administrator Agreement previously approved by the Court, and such compensation will further reduce funds available for distribution by the Estates.
