# ORDER GRANTING CITY OF DETROIT'S MOTION FOR THE ENTRY OF AN ORDER ENFORCING THE CONFIRMATION ORDER AND THE <u>CITY'S CONFIRMED PLAN AGAINST LORENZO RIPPY</u>

This matter, having come before the Court on the *City of Detroit's Motion for the Entry of an Order Enforcing the Confirmation Order and the City's Confirmed Plan Against Lorenzo Rippy* ("<u>Motion</u>"),<sup>1</sup> upon proper notice and a hearing, the Court being fully advised in the premises, and there being good cause to grant the relief requested,

### THE COURT ORDERS THAT:

1. The Motion is granted.

2. Within five days business days of the entry of this Order, Lorenzo Rippy shall dismiss, or cause to be dismissed, with prejudice the lawsuit captioned as *Lorenzo Rippy v. City of Detroit, General Retirement System for the City of Detroit, Board of Trustee* [sic] *for the General Retirement System*, case number 25-

4. The Court shall retain jurisdiction over any and all matters arising from the enforcement, interpretation or implementation of this Order.
