ORDER GRANTING CITY OF DETROIT'S MOTION FOR THE ENTRY OF AN ORDER ENFORCING THE CONFIRMATION ORDER AND THE CITY'S CONFIRMED PLAN AGAINST LORENZO RIPPY

filed. Upon proper notice, the Court finds good cause to enter this Order.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The Motion is granted.
- 2. No later than July 10, 2025, Lorenzo Rippy must dismiss, or cause to

be dismissed, with prejudice the lawsuit captioned as Lorenzo Rippy v. City of

Detroit, General Retirement System for the City of Detroit, Board of Trustee [sic]

for the General Retirement System, case number 25-003999-CZ currently pending in the Circuit Court for the County of Wayne, Michigan (the "Lawsuit")

3. Lorenzo Rippy is permanently barred, estopped and enjoined from asserting the claims asserted in the Lawsuit or claims arising from or related to the Lawsuit against the City of Detroit, the GRS, the Board of Trustees of the GRS, or property of the City of Detroit.

4. The Court will retain jurisdiction over any and all matters arising from the enforcement, interpretation or implementation of this Order.
