- c. The professionals included in the Second Interim Application did not vary their hourly rates based on the geographic location of the bankruptcy cases.
- d. The Second Interim Application did not include any fees dedicated to revising time records or preparing and revising invoices that would not normally be compensable outside of bankruptcy.
- e. The time period covered by the Second Interim Application includes approximately 6.00 hours with a value of \$6,510.00 spent by Young Conaway to ensure that the time entries subject to the Second Interim Application comply with the Local Rules of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware and do not disclose privileged or confidential information. This review, and any revisions associated therewith, are a necessary component of Young Conaway's preparation of each monthly fee application.
- f. The Second Interim Application did not include any rate increases since the effective date of the Court's approval of Young Conaway's retention.
