PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE THAT the *Order (I) Establishing Procedures for Interim Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses for Retained Professionals and (II) Granting Related Relief* [Docket No. 317] (the “Interim Compensation Procedures”) and Rule 1075-1 of the Local Bankruptcy Rules (the “Local Bankruptcy Rules”), by which the Court has adopted the “Procedures for Complex Chapter 11 Cases in the Eastern District of Virginia” (the “Case Management Procedures” and together with the Interim Compensation Procedures, the “Procedures”), prescribe the manner in which objections must be filed and served and when hearings will be conducted.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE THAT the Application is scheduled to be heard before the Court at the hearing currently scheduled for **January 16, 2025, at 2:00 p.m.** Eastern Prevailing Time, in the United States Bankruptcy Court, 200 S. Washington St., Courtroom I, Alexandria, Virginia 22314. The hearing will be conducted by remote video conference and in person, as directed by the Court pursuant to the *Case Management Order No. 3* [Docket No. 881]. Additional information regarding procedures for hearings before the Court, including videoconference hearings, is available by visiting the Court's website at: <https://www.vaeb.uscourts.gov/>. If you fail to (i) file timely a written response and (ii) attend the hearing (even if a response is timely filed), the Court may consider your objection waived and enter an order granting the relief requested.
