**EXAMINER'S *EX PARTE* MOTION FOR ORDER PERMITTING EXAMINER
 TO FILE UNDER SEAL NOTICE OF PRODUCING PARTY OBJECTIONS TO
 ALTERNATIVE A DOCUMENT LIST AND ALTERNATIVE B DOCUMENT
 LIST IN FURTHERANCE OF MOTION FOR ORDER GRANTING CERTAIN
 RELIEF AND ESTABLISHING CERTAIN PROCEDURES RELATED TO
CONCLUSION OF EXAMINATION**



Ralph R. Mabey, in his capacity as examiner (the "Examiner") pursuant to this Court's order dated September 29, 2009 [Docket No. 455], hereby requests the entry of an *ex parte* order allowing the Examiner to file under seal the following document: "Examiner's Notice of Producing Party Objections to Alternative A Document and Alternative B Document List in Furtherance of Motion For Order Granting Certain Relief and Establishing Certain Procedures Related to Conclusion of Examination" ("*Ex Parte* Motion").

In support of this *Ex Parte* Motion, the Examiner respectfully represents as follows:

1. The Examiner completed his Court-order investigation and on April 8, 2010, publicly filed his report exhibits, which details his factual and legal conclusions [Docket No, 913] and a separate volume of exhibits.
2. On May 25, 2010 the Examiner filed the "Examiner's Motion for Order Granting Certain Relief and Establishing Certain Procedures Related to Conclusion of Examination" (the "Motion") [Docket No. 1012]. As discussed in the Motion, to maintain the viability of each of the alternative proposals regarding the disposition of the document repository created in the course of the Examiner's investigation, the Examiner provided an Alternative A Document List and an Alternative B Document List (each as defined in the Motion, and, collectively, the "Lists")¹ to each party that produced documents under a confidentiality agreement. In paragraphs 10 and 13 of the Motion, the Examiner indicated that he would notify the Court of any objections to the inclusion of any List in a Master Document List or Report Document List (each as defined in the Motion), and provide copies of the disputed lists to the Court. The disputed Lists must be filed under seal pending this Court's determination of whether they contain confidential

¹ As detailed in the Motion, each of the Lists sets forth the names of the documents that a party has produced to the Examiner, and does not provide the name of any other party's documents. The Examiner provided the Lists each party as described in the Motion.

information to preserve confidentiality, if any. The following parties object to any disclosure of their respective Lists:

- Extended Stay Inc. and its debtor affiliates, as debtors and debtors in possession;²

- David Lichtenstein and Lightstone Holdings LLC; and
- BHAC IV, L.L.C. and BRE/HV Holdings L.L.C.

3. The Examiner hereby requests permission to file the Lists under seal with the Court or in the alternative to allow Examiner's Counsel to hand them up at the hearing regarding the Motion, currently scheduled for June 17, 2010 at 10:00 a.m.

CONCLUSION

Based on the forgoing, the Examiner respectfully requests that the Court enter an order, substantially in the form annexed hereto as Exhibit "A", (i) allowing the Examiner to file the Lists under seal; or (ii) allowing Counsel for the Examiner to hand the lists up at the hearing regarding the Motion; and (ii) granting such other and further relief as is appropriate under the circumstances
