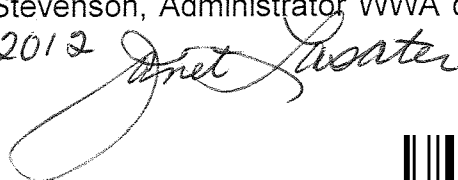
Janet Palmer Lasater, Trustee, objects to the transfer of Claim Number 5024. A copy of the proposed transfer of filed claim is attached hereto.

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BRIEF

A copy of the claim filed by Janet Palmer Lasater, Trustee, in October, 2010 is attached hereto. Daniel L. Palmer, Sr., now deceased, is the father of Janet Palmer Lasater, Lena Vidahl, George Palmer and Daniel L. Palmer, Jr. In 2001, when Mr. Palmer was of sound mind, he signed a will and trust, which (after providing for his wife, who later predeceased him) divided all his assets at his death one-fourth to each child.

In his later years, Mr. Palmer was infirm. He was subject to undue influence and duress by Lena Vidahl, who used that influence to get him to sign papers diverting various assets to herself -- in contradiction of the intent he expressed many times both orally and in writing that division of assets should be made equally among the four children. Mr. Palmer did not formally put his Fair Finance assets into his trust. Ms. Lasater's intent in filing the claim in 2010 was to make sure that the claim was preserved so that she, acting generally as trustee, could divide any proceeds equally among the four children or have the asset go into Mr. Palmer's estate.

Ms. Vidahl is entitled only to her fractional share of this asset. She is not entitled to benefit from the undue influence and duress she exercised in this and other instances in order to deprive her siblings of their fair shares of their father's assets.
