DECLARATION OF JAMES LEE OF KURTZMAN CARSON CONSULTANTS, LLC DBA VERITA GLOBAL REGARDING THE SOLICITATION AND TABULATION OF BALLOTS CAST ON THE AMENDED JOINT CHAPTER 11 PLAN OF LIQUIDATION

- I, James Lee, declare under the penalty of perjury that the following is true and correct to the best of my knowledge, information, and belief:
- 1. I am a Vice President of Public Securities Services employed by Kurtzman Carson Consultants, LLC dba Verita Global ("Verita"), whose main business address is 222 N. Pacific Coast Highway, Suite 300, El Segundo, California, 90245. I am over the age of eighteen years and not a party to the above-captioned action. Unless otherwise noted, I have personal knowledge of the facts set forth herein.
- 2. I submit this declaration (this "<u>Declaration</u>") with respect to the solicitation and the tabulation of ballots cast on the *Amended Joint Chapter 11 Plan of Liquidation* [D.I. 456] (as may be amended, supplemented, or modified from time to time, the "<u>Plan</u>").² Except as otherwise indicated herein, all facts set forth herein are based on my personal knowledge or my

The debtors and debtors in possession in these chapter 11 cases, along with each debtor's federal tax identification numbers are: Fulcrum BioEnergy, Inc. review of relevant documents. I am authorized to submit this Declaration on behalf of Verita. If I were called to testify, I could and would testify competently as to the facts set forth herein.

- 3. In accordance with the (a) Order Authorizing the Debtors to Employ and Retain Kurtzman Carson Consultants, LLC dba Verita Global as Administrative Advisor Effective as of the Petition Date [D.I. 168] (the "Retention Order"), (b) Order (I) Authorizing Kurtzman Carson Consultants, LLC dba Verita Global as Solicitation Agent to the Debtors Nunc Pro Tunc to January 1, 2025 and (II) Granting Related Relief [D.I. 412] (the "Solicitation Agent Order"), and (c) Order (I) Approving the Disclosure Statement; (II) Establishing Procedures for Solicitation and Tabulation of Votes to Accept or Reject the Plan; (III) Approving the Form of Ballot and Solicitation Packages; (IV) Establishing the Voting Record Date; (V) Scheduling a Hearing and Establishing Notice and Objection Procedures in Respect of Confirmation of the Plan; and (VI) Granting Related Relief [D.I. 458] (the "Disclosure Statement Order"), Verita was appointed and authorized to assist the Debtors with, inter alia, soliciting, receiving, reviewing, determining the validity of, and tabulating Ballots cast on the Plan by holders of Claims or Interests in the Voting Classes (as defined herein).
- 4. As set forth in the Disclosure Statement Order, the Debtors established March 6, 2025 as the record date (the "Voting Record Date") for determining which holders of Claims or Interests within the Voting Classes were entitled to vote on the Plan. Under the Plan, holders of Claims in Classes 2A (Fulcrum Prepetition Loan Secured Claims), 2B (Holdings Prepetition Bond Secured Claims), 2C (BioFuels Prepetition Bond Secured Claims), 3A (Fulcrum Deficiency Claims), 3B (Holdings Deficiency Claims), 3C (BioFuels Deficiency Claimssts), 4A (Fulcrum Undersecured and General Unsecured Claims), 4B (Holdings Undersecured and General

Unsecured Claims) and 4C (BioFuels Undersecured and General Unsecured Claims) (together, the "Voting Classes") were entitled to vote to accept or reject the Plan.

- 5. The procedures for the solicitation and tabulation of votes on the Plan are outlined in the Disclosure Statement Order. Verita was instructed by the Debtors to solicit, review, determine the validity of, and tabulate Ballots and Master Ballots submitted with respect to the Plan by the holders of Claims in the Voting Classes in accordance with the Disclosure Statement Order. In addition, Verita consulted with the Debtors and their counsel, as appropriate, to ensure compliance with the Disclosure Statement Order.
- 6. Specifically, pursuant to the Disclosure Statement Order, Verita relied on the Debtors' Schedules of Assets and Liabilities and the Claims information reflected in Verita's CaseView³ system to identify and solicit holders of Claims in the Voting Classes. Verita also relied on security position reports provided by the Depository Trust Company ("<u>DTC</u>") as of the Voting Record Date to identify the banks and brokerage firms (the "<u>Nominees</u>") of Classes 2B, 2C, 3B, 3C and 4A whose Beneficial Holders are entitled to vote to accept or reject the Plan.
- 7. In accordance with the Disclosure Statement Order, on March 13, 2025, Verita caused to be served the Solicitation Package, which consisted of the following materials: (a) a USB flash drive containing the (i) Disclosure Statement (with Plan attached as Exhibit A) and (ii) Disclosure Statement Order (without exhibits); (b) a printed copy of the appropriate Ballot(s) and voting instructions for the Voting Class in which the respective holder of a Claim was entitled to vote; (c) the Confirmation Hearing Notice, which was served on (i) the U.S. Trustee, (ii) the Voting Classes; (iii) all entities that are parties to Executory Contracts and Unexpired Leases with the

Debtors; (iv) all entities that are parties to litigation with the Debtors; (v) all current and former employees, directors, and officers on the Debtors' consolidated list of creditors; (vi) all regulatory authorities that regulate the Debtors' business; (vii) the office of the attorney general for each state in which the Debtors maintain(ed) or conduct(ed) business; (viii) all taxing authorities for the jurisdictions in which the Debtors maintain or conduct business; (ix) the Securities Exchange Commission; (x) all parties who filed a request for service of notices under Bankruptcy Rule 2002 and all parties on the Debtors' consolidated list of creditors that are not otherwise a holder of a Claim or Interest in a Non-Voting Class; and (xi) to the extent not otherwise listed in the foregoing, all parties on the creditor matrix; and (d) where applicable, a pre-addressed, postage pre-paid return envelope.

- 8. On March 13, 2025, in accordance with the Disclosure Statement Order, Verita further caused to be served the Non-Voting Notice on all known Holders of Claims and Interests in Class 1 (Other Priority Claims) and Class 5 (Interests) (collectively, the "Non-Voting Classes").
- 9. Verita filed the *Certificate of Service re: Solicitation Materials Served on March* 13, 2025 on April 1, 2025 [D.I. 510].
- 10. On March 13, 2025, Verita posted links to the electronic versions of the Disclosure Statement Order, Disclosure Statement (with Plan attached as Exhibit A), Non-Voting Notice and Confirmation Hearing Notice on the public access website at www.veritaglobal.net/fulcrum.
- 11. On March 18, 2025, the Confirmation Hearing Notice was published in the *Wall Street Journal*. The *Affidavit of Publication* evidencing the publication of the Confirmation Hearing Notice was filed with the Court on October 29, 2024 [D.I. 486].

- 12. Each Ballot received by Verita was date-stamped upon receipt, scanned (if submitted on paper), assigned a ballot number, and processed in accordance with the Disclosure Statement Order.
- 13. Verita received, reviewed, determined the validity of, and tabulated the Ballots submitted to vote on the Plan. For a Ballot to be counted as valid, the Ballot must have been (a) properly completed pursuant to the Disclosure Statement Order, (b) executed by the relevant holder or such holder's authorized representative, (c) returned to Verita via an approved method of delivery as set forth in the Disclosure Statement Order, and (d) received by Verita by 4:00 p.m. Eastern Time on March 31, 2025 (the "Voting Deadline").
- 14. All validly executed Ballots cast by holders of Claims or Master Ballots cast by the Nominee (as defined herein) that were received by Verita on or before the Voting Deadline were tabulated as outlined in the procedures set forth in the Disclosure Statement Order. The results of the voting by holders of Claims in the Voting Classes are as set forth in **Exhibit A** hereto, which is a true and correct copy of the final tabulation of votes received by Verita. The detailed Ballot reports for Classes 2A (Fulcrum Prepetition Loan Secured Claims), 2B (Holdings Prepetition Bond Secured Claims), 2C (BioFuels Prepetition Bond Secured Claims), 3A (Fulcrum Deficiency Claims), 3B (Holdings Deficiency Claims), 3C (BioFuels Deficiency Claimssts), 4A (Fulcrum Undersecured and General Unsecured Claims) and 4C (BioFuels Undersecured and General Unsecured Claims) are attached to this declaration as **Exhibit A-1**, **Exhibit A-2**, **Exhibit A-3**, **Exhibit A-4**, **Exhibit A-5** and **Exhibit A-6**, respectively.
- 15. A report of any Ballots from parties in the Voting Classes excluded from the final tabulation, and the reasons for exclusion of such Ballots, is attached hereto as **Exhibit B**. All such

Ballots were not counted because they did not satisfy the requirements for a valid Ballot set forth

in the Disclosure Statement Order..

16. Verita also reviewed and documented elections recorded on the Ballots and

Beneficial Holder Ballots from holders of Claims in the Voting Classes that checked the box on

such Ballot or Beneficial Holder Ballot to opt out of the Releases by Holders of Claims or Interests.

A report of all Entities who opted out of the Releases by Holders of Claims or Interests by checking

the opt out box on the their Ballot or Beneficial Holder Ballot is attached hereto as Exhibit C.⁴

For the avoidance of doubt, this Declaration does not certify the validity or enforceability of any

opt out elections received, including those reported on **Exhibit C**, but rather is providing these opt

out election results for reporting and informational purposes only.

17. To the best of my knowledge, information, and belief, the foregoing information

concerning the distribution, submission, and tabulation of Ballots in connection with the Plan is

true and correct.
