1 P R O C E E D I N G S

2 THE COURT: Good morning, everybody. Are the parties
3 ready on Garrett Motion?

4 MR. GLUECKSTEIN: Yes. Good morning, Your Honor.
5 This is Brian Glueckstein, Sullivan & Cromwell, on behalf of
6 the reorganized debtor.

7 THE COURT: Okay.

8 MR. GLUECKSTEIN: Your Honor, we're here today for an
9 omnibus hearing in the Chapter 11 cases of reorganized Garrett.
10 As reflected on the agenda filed at docket 1426, there are no
11 matters going forward today, but we are appearing at the
12 Court's request to provide a status update on the pending
13 matters that have been continued to the October omnibus hearing
14 scheduled for October 26th.

15 Your Honor, since it's been some time since we've
16 appeared before Your Honor in this case, I thought it might be
17 helpful to provide the Court a brief status update on the
18 Chapter 11 proceedings.

19 THE COURT: Okay.

20 MR. GLUECKSTEIN: As Your Honor will recall, Garrett's
21 plan of reorganization went effective on April 30th. Since
22 that time, Garrett has relisted on NASDAQ and the operational
23 business is thriving. We have been working with the company
24 and its advisors to reconcile the remaining claims with the
25 goal being to close the remaining lead case, Garrett Motion

1 Inc., as soon as practicable.

2 To that end, we have previously filed notices of
3 satisfied claims in interest that addressed more than 1,800 of
4 the approximately 2,500 claims filed in these cases. Others
5 have been resolved by stipulation. Of the remaining unresolved
6 claims that are being reviewed, most are 510(b) claims which,
7 as the Court knows, those claims are being liquidated in the
8 pending district court litigation through the class proof of
9 claim that was authorized back in June.

10 Of the small number of remaining other claims, the
11 reorganized debtor is working with the respective
12 counterparties to reconcile and resolve those claims, which is
13 progressing well. Of course, the reorganized debtor retains
14 the right to object to any claims that cannot be consensually
15 resolved, but we are not anticipating any significant claims
16 litigation at this time.

17 Unless the Court has any general questions, I can
18 briefly address the three matters that were adjourned to the
19 October omnibus hearing.

20 THE COURT: No. Thank you for that report. If you
21 would just proceed to address that matters that otherwise would
22 have been scheduled for today, I'd appreciate it.

23 MR. GLUECKSTEIN: Sure. Thank you, Your Honor. The
24 first item on the agenda is the administrative claim motion
25 that was filed by Gits Manufacturing. That motion represents

1 the last of the remaining administrative claim motions that the
2 reorganized debtor is still working to resolve. As annexed to
3 that motion, there are a significant number of invoices that
4 have been put at issue which the company and Gits have been
5 working in good faith diligently to reconcile at the business
6 level. Most of those have now been resolved, and Garrett is
7 paying those reconciled invoices as they've become due.

8 We anticipate the process to resolve the remaining
9 invoices will be completed very soon in due course, after which
10 we anticipate filing a stipulation resolving this pending
11 motion in a form similar to those recently filed resolving the
12 other administrative claims motions that have been filed in the
13 case.

14 THE COURT: And how long do you think that is going to
15 take?

16 MR. GLUECKSTEIN: I think -- we are hopeful, Your
17 Honor, and it's certainly our expectation anyway, that will be
18 completed, hopefully, in advance of the October hearing that we
19 have adjourned it to. It's take a little bit longer than we
20 had hoped, but the report from the business team is that they
21 are getting down to the smaller strokes, so we do anticipate
22 that to be able to complete in the next few weeks.

23 THE COURT: Okay. And how about GM, Fuel Cell, and
24 Honeywell?

25 MR. GLUECKSTEIN: So the GM matter, Your Honor,

1 concerns an objection that was filed to the assumption of
2 certain customer contracts that were entered into between
3 Garrett and Fuel Cell Systems, which is a joint venture
4 involving two OEM customers: General Motors and Honda.
5 Garrett has been in protracted discussions with both GM and
6 Honda regarding resolution of certain outstanding issues
7 related to those pre-petition contracts, as well as the go-
8 forward business arrangements with each of those customers.
9 While it has been taking some time to resolve, we anticipate a
10 resolution of these matters.

11 With respect to the go forward business arrangements,
12 we'll also resolve the pending contract assumption objections,
13 which, Your Honor, again, we had hoped would be resolved prior
14 to now, but we are in active discussions with those parties,
15 and I am told by the Garrett team that there is an expectation
16 that those negotiations will be completed prior to the October
17 omnibus hearing to which these motions have been adjourned.

18 THE COURT: And Honeywell?

19 MR. GLUECKSTEIN: Honeywell, Your Honor, the limited
20 issue that is technically pending and has been adjourned is
21 Honeywell's right to object to what are relatively minor cure
22 amounts with respect to ordinary course contracts that were
23 already assumed pursuant to the plan. We have been in
24 discussions with Honeywell to resolve not only these amounts,
25 but to do so as part of a resolution of the remaining portion

1 of Honeywell's proofs of claim that remain pending and
2 outstanding. And we're trying to wrap up all of the remaining
3 Honeywell claims issues at the same time.

4 Good progress has been made, I'm happy to report.
5 Although there are certain claims as part of the Honeywell
6 claims that remain outstanding and subject to ongoing
7 discussions between the parties, we are hopeful that a global
8 resolution with respect to Honeywell's claims, which would
9 include these cure amounts, can be reached soon that would
10 resolve all remaining ordinary course pending matters and claim
11 matters between Honeywell and the debtors.

12 I don't have as clear a time line on the broader
13 resolution. There have been, as I say, active discussions that
14 are ongoing, but we are very hopeful that those can, again, be
15 resolved within the time frame before the next omnibus hearing.
16 And, again, that would be a broader resolution than simply
17 these cure amounts that are the only issue that is technically
18 before the Court at this time.

19 THE COURT: One reason I asked for this conference is
20 that it happens often in the big cases, especially where there
21 are objection deadlines that people file objections but (audio
22 interference) we get a long series of adjournments. We have to
23 track those, unfortunately. We actually have to report things
24 that have been outstanding for a certain amount of time, and we
25 don't have good tools to do it, so it starts to become an

1 administrative burden for the court. And when I get a lot of
2 adjournments, then I want to know exactly what's happening.
3 And in another case recently what we did was consider the
4 objection withdrawn without prejudice but with an order that
5 says that the objection can be reinstated, and if reinstated,
6 will be effective as of its original date in the event the
7 parties don't work things out.

8 Are any of these matters appropriate for that kind of
9 a resolution?

10 MR. GLUECKSTEIN: They very well might be, Your Honor,
11 and I think that's a very helpful suggestion. What I would
12 suggest, as far as a path forward, is we'll go back and talk to
13 the counsel for the respective counterparties on these three
14 matters, continuing to work to try to resolve them in the
15 immediate term. And if that's not going to happen in the next
16 week or two, I think your suggestion would make sense, at least
17 with respect to the pending motions, but of course, we'd need
18 the consent of the other parties to do so.

19 THE COURT: All right. I appreciate that. Anything
20 else for today then?

21 MR. GLUECKSTEIN: Not from us, Your Honor. And
22 appreciate the Court's time this morning.

23 THE COURT: Okay. Thank you for your report.


