Addendum to Proof of Claim - Fisher BioServices In re Gritstone bio, Inc. (Bankr. D. Del., Case No. 4-12305-KBO)

- 1. Fisher BioServices ("Claimant"), files this Proof of Claim evidencing Claimant's claims against Debtor Gritstone bio, Inc. ("Debtor"), in the Chapter 11 case filed October 10, 2024 (the "Petition Date").
- 2. Claimant's claims against the Debtor (collectively, the "Claim(s)") arise from, among other things, unpaid amounts for leased warehouse space and services provided to the Debtor before and after the Petition Date under certain agreements (collectively, the "Contract"). As of this time the contract has not been assumed or rejected but Debtor has moved to reject the Contract.

Claimant will file that claim within 30 days after contract rejection. Claimant also is owed amounts for postpetition services and rents. Claimant will also file its administrative claim for unpaid postpetition services and rents including actually incurred or anticipated disposition service costs by the applicable bar date, and Claimant expressly reserves the right to amend this Proof of Claim to assert such claims.
- 4. <u>Supporting Documentation</u>. Documents supporting this Claim are confidential and proprietary. A summary of the Claims, reflecting invoice numbers, dates and amounts, is attached hereto as **Exhibit A**. Such documents will be provided to Debtor upon request.
