DECLARATION OF JEFFREY MILLER WITH RESPECT

TO THE TABULATION OF VOTES ON GRITSTONE BIO, INC.'S FIRST MODIFIED CHAPTER 11 PLAN OF REORGANIZATION

I, Jeffrey Miller, depose and say under the penalty of perjury:

1. I am a Managing Director of Corporate Restructuring Services, employed by Kurtzman Carson Consultants LLC dba Verita Global ("Verita"), located at 222 N. Pacific Coast Highway, 3rd Floor, El Segundo, California 90245. I am over the age of 18 and not a party to

these proceedings.

2. I submit this declaration (the "<u>Voting Declaration</u>") with respect to the solicitation of votes and the tabulation of Ballots cast on the solicitation version of the *Gritstone bio, Inc.'s First Modified Chapter 11 Plan of Reorganization* (Docket No. 452) (the "<u>Plan</u>") and the *First Amended Disclosure Statement with Respect to Gritstone bio, Inc.'s First Modified Chapter 11 Plan of Reorganization* (Docket No. 453) (the "<u>Disclosure Statement</u>") (as may be amended, supplemented, or modified from time to time, the Plan and Disclosure Statement) filed on February

14, 2025 by the above-captioned debtor. Except as otherwise noted, all facts set forth herein are



based on my personal knowledge, knowledge that I acquired from individuals under my supervision, and my review of relevant documents. I am authorized to submit this Voting Certification on behalf of Verita. If I were called to testify, I could and would testify competently as to the facts set forth herein.

3. The Court authorized the retention of Verita (i) as the claims and noticing agent to the Debtor pursuant to the *Order Appointing Kurtzman Carson Consultants, LLC, dba Verita Global, as Claims and Noticing Agent, Effective as of the Petition Date* (Docket No. 38) entered on October 16, 2024, and (ii) as administrative advisor to the Debtor pursuant to the *Order Authorizing the Debtor to Employ and Retain Kurtzman Carson Consultants, LLC dba Verita Global as Administrative Advisor Effective as of the Petition Date* (Docket No. 218) entered on December 4, 2024 (collectively, the "Retention Orders"). The Retention Orders authorize Verita to assist the Debtor with, among other things, the service of solicitation materials and tabulation of votes cast to accept or reject the Plan. Verita and its employees have considerable experience in soliciting and tabulating votes to accept or reject proposed chapter 11 plans.

#### A. Service and Transmittal of Solicitation Packages and Related Information

4. On February 12, 2025, the Court entered the Order (I) Approving the Disclosure Statement; (II) Scheduling Confirmation Hearing; (III) Approving Form and Manner of Notice of Confirmation Hearing; (IV) Establishing Procedures for Solicitation and Tabulation of Votes to Accept or Reject Plan, Including (A) Approving Form and Content of Solicitation Materials; (B) Establishing Record Date and Approving Procedures for Distribution of Solicitation Materials; (C) Approving Forms of Ballots; (D) Establishing Voting Deadline for Receipt of Ballots and (E) Approving Procedures for Vote Tabulations; (V) Approving Form and Manner of Notice of Plan Releases; (VI) Establishing Deadline and Procedures for Filing Objections to Confirmation of

Plan; and (VII) Granting Related Relief (Docket No. 442) (the "Disclosure Statement Order"). The Disclosure Statement Order established, among other things, (i) February 12, 2025 as the record date (the "Voting Record Date") for determining the Holders of Claims and Interests entitled to vote on the Plan, (ii) procedures for the solicitation of votes to accept or reject the Plan (the "Solicitation Procedures") and (iii) procedures for the tabulation of Ballots (the "Tabulation Procedures"). Pursuant to the Plan and the Solicitation Procedures, only Holders of Claims as of the Voting Record Date in of Claims in Class 1 (Prepetition Secured Claims), Class 3 (Secured Tax Claims), Class 4 (Priority Non-Tax Claims)<sup>2</sup>, Class 5 (General Unsecured Claims), and Class 6 (Convenience Claims) (the "Voting Classes") were entitled to vote to accept or reject the Plan.

5. In accordance with the Disclosure Statement Order, on February 14, 2025, Verita caused to be served (i) the Confirmation Hearing Notice to creditors and parties in interest entitled to receive such notice pursuant to the Disclosure Statement Order, (ii) the Solicitation Packages on all Holders of Claims in the Voting Classes entitled to vote as of the Voting Record Date, and (iii) the appropriate Notice of Non-Voting Status in lieu of Solicitation Packages to the Holders of Claims and Interests in the following Classes (which were not entitled to vote on the Plan): Class 2 (Other Secured Claims), Class 7 (Subordinated Claims) 3, and Class 8 (Equity Interests). Additionally, on February 18, 2025, Verita caused to be served supplemental Non-Voting Interest Holder Confirmation Hearing Notice. A certificate of service evidencing the foregoing was filed with the Court on March 10, 2025 [Docket No. 502]. Furthermore, on or before March 13, 2025, Verita caused the Solicitation Package to be served on an additional Holder of Claims in a Voting

Class entitled to vote as of the Voting Record Date. A supplemental certificate of service evidencing the foregoing was filed with the Court on March 19, 2025 [Docket No. 538].

6. On February 14, 2025, Verita also posted links to the electronic versions of the solicitation materials, including the Confirmation Hearing Notice, Plan, Disclosure Statement, Disclosure Statement Order (excluding exhibits thereto), on the public access website at www.veritaglobal.net/gritstone.

#### **B.** Voting and Tabulation Process

- 7. The Disclosure Statement Order established February 12, 2025, as the Voting Record Date. Pursuant to the Disclosure Statement Order, Holders of Claims in Class 1 (Prepetition Secured Claims), Class 3 (Secured Tax Claims), Class 4 (Priority Non-Tax Claims), Class 5 (General Unsecured Claims), and Class 6 (Convenience Claims) were entitled to vote to accept or reject the Plan. No other classes were entitled to vote on the Plan.
- 8. Pursuant to the Disclosure Statement Order, Verita relied on the Debtor's Schedules of Assets and Liabilities and the Claims information reflected in Verita's CaseView system ("CaseView")<sup>4</sup> to identify and solicit Holders of Claims in the Voting Class.
- 9. Using the information outlined above, and with specific guidance from Debtor's counsel, Verita created a voting database reflecting the names and addresses, classification and voting amounts of Holders of Claims in the Voting Classes. Specifically, using its CaseView system and voting database, Verita generated Ballots for Holders of Claims entitled to vote to accept or reject the Plan.

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CaseView is Verita's claims management database, which stores the records and images associated with all scheduled and filed claims.

- Time) as the deadline by which Ballots for accepting or rejecting the Plan had to be actually received by Verita in order to be counted (the "Voting Deadline"), except to the extent such Voting Deadline was extended by the Debtor in writing in their sole discretion.
- 11. In accordance with the Disclosure Statement Order, Verita received and tabulated the Ballots as follows: (a) each returned paper Ballot was opened and inspected at Verita's office; (b) paper Ballots were date-stamped and scanned into Verita CaseView; (c) each electronic Ballot was electronically received and processed; and (d) all Ballots received on or before the Voting Deadline were then entered into Verita CaseView and tabulated in accordance with the Voting and Tabulation Procedures.
- 12. The final tabulation of votes cast by timely and properly completed Ballots received by Verita is set forth below and attached hereto as **Exhibit A**, with a detailed ballot report for the Voting Classes attached hereto as **Exhibit A-1** through **Exhibit A-4**.
- 13. A report of any Ballots from parties in the Voting Classes excluded from the final tabulation, and the reasons for exclusion of such Ballots, is attached hereto as **Exhibit B**. All such Ballots were not counted because they did not satisfy the requirements for a valid Ballot set forth in the Disclosure Statement Order.
