Pursuant to sections 330 and 331 of title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code"), rule 2016 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure (the "Bankruptcy Rules"), rule 2016-1 of the Local Rules of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware (the "Local Rules"), the Order Establishing Procedures for Interim Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses of Professionals (the "Interim Compensation Order") [Docket No. 154], the consulting firm FTI Consulting, Inc., together with its wholly owned subsidiaries ("FTI"), as financial advisor to the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors (the "Committee") appointed in this chapter 11 case, hereby submits this application (the "Application") for the period March 1, 2025 through

BACKGROUND

- 1. On October 10, 2024 (the "<u>Petition Date</u>"), the Debtor commenced this chapter 11 case by filing a petition for relief under chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code (the "<u>Chapter 11</u> <u>Case</u>").
- 2. On October 29, 2024, the U.S. Trustee appointed the Committee. *See* Docket No. 77. At the formation meeting the Committee selected ArentFox Schiff LLP as its counsel and Potter Anderson & Corroon LLP as its Delaware counsel. On November 1, 2024, the Committee selected FTI as its financial advisor. The Committee consists of the following three members:
 - a) BMR-Sidney Research Campus LLC;
 - b) Presidio; and
 - c) Murigenics, Inc.
- 3. On December 13, 2024, the Court entered the *Order Authorizing Retention of FTI Consulting, Inc. as Financial Advisor for the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors* [Docket No. 256] (the "Retention Order").
- 4. On April 2, 2025, the Court held a hearing confirming the Debtor's Plan of Reorganization, and on April 3, 2025, the Court entered the *Order Confirming Gritstone bio, Inc.'s Second Modified Chapter 11 Plan of Reorganization* [Docket No. 601] (the "Confirmation Order"). On April 4, 2025, the Plan of Reorganization went effective.

RELIEF REQUESTED

5. FTI submits this Application pursuant to the Bankruptcy Rules, the Interim Compensation Order, and the Retention Order. By this Application, FTI seeks interim allowance of compensation for actual and necessary professional services rendered in the amount of \$8,601.50 for the Monthly Fee Period in accordance with the terms of the Interim Compensation

Order. FTI reserves the right to request, in subsequent fee applications, reimbursement of any additional fees or expenses incurred during the Monthly Fee Period, which may not have been captured in FTI's billing system as of the date of filing this Application.

SUMMARY OF FEES

- 6. The total number of hours expended by FTI professionals and paraprofessionals in performing professional services for the Committee during the Monthly Fee Period was 8.3 hours. Pursuant to the Retention Order, FTI is entitled to monthly compensation for its services provided to the Committee at its current hourly rates, plus reimbursement of necessary out of pocket expenses.
- 7. Services rendered by (i) each professional and paraprofessional, (ii) a summary of the time incurred by task, and (iii) detailed time entries during the Monthly Fee Period are attached hereto as **Exhibit A**, **Exhibit B**, and **Exhibit C**, respectively.

ACTUAL AND NECESSARY EXPENSES

8. FTI is not seeking reimbursement for meal expenses for this Monthly Fee Period. FTI reserves the right to request, in subsequent fee applications, reimbursement of any additional expenses incurred during the Monthly Fee Period, as such expenses may not have been captured in FTI's billing system on the date of filing this Fee Application.

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CONCLUSION

WHEREFORE, FTI respectfully requests, pursuant to the Interim Compensation Order, interim allowance of monthly compensation for actual and necessary professional services rendered as financial advisor to the Committee during the Monthly Fee Period in the amount of (i) 80% of fees incurred during the Monthly Fee Period in the amount of \$6,881.20 (representing 80% of \$8,601.50), and such other and further relief that the Court deems just and proper.
