



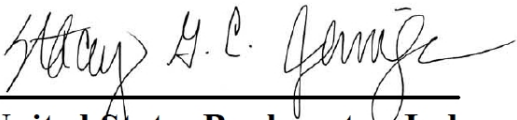

**ORDER DENYING DEFENDANT'S EMERGENCY MOTION TO STAY
