The material delivered under this order shall not be deemed a future, but shall remain the property of and subject to removal by the seller until fully paid for. The FINANCE CHARGE is computed on the basis of a periodic rate of 1 1/2% per month or the maximum that is allowed by law, not to exceed 1 1/2% per month. The FINANCE CHARGE is applied to the previous balance on the statement date of each month. The FINANCE CHARGE for the next month will be imposed on any purchase not paid in terms. The ANNUAL PERCENTAGE RATE IS 18% or the maximum rate that is allowed by law, not to exceed 18% per annum. A MINIMUM CHARGE OF \$20.00 may be imposed on any returned check.
