Upon consideration of the First Interim Application of Foley & Lardner LLP for Allowance and Payment of Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses Incurred as Counsel to the Debtors for the Period from June 17, 2025, through October 31, 2025 (the "Interim Fee Application")² for interim allowance of compensation of professional services rendered as counsel of Higher Ground Education, Inc. ("HGE") and its affiliated reorganized debtors (collectively, the "Reorganized Debtors") in the above-captioned chapter 11 cases (the "Chapter 11 Cases") during the period of June 17, 2025, through and including October 31, 2025 (the "Interim Fee Period").
