**MOTION FOR ADMISSION OF DAVID COX TO PRACTICE,
PRO HAC VICE, UNDER LOCAL BANKRUPTCY RULE 2090-1(E)(3)**

Jeffrey A. Liesemer (“**Movant**”) hereby moves (by this “**Motion**”) this Court, in accordance with Rule 2090-1(E)(3) of the Local Rules of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Virginia, for entry of an order, substantially in the form of order attached hereto as Exhibit A (“**Order**”), authorizing David Cox, a partner of the law firm of Morgan, Lewis & Bockius, LLP, (“**Morgan Lewis**”), 300 South Grand Avenue, Los Angeles, California, Suite 2200, 90071, to appear *pro hac vice* to represent the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors (“**Committee**”) in the above-captioned case (“**Bankruptcy Case**”) and any related proceedings.

In support of this Motion, Movant states as follows:



1. This Court has subject matter jurisdiction to consider this matter under 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334. This is a core proceeding under 28 U.S.C. § 157(b). Venue is proper before this Court under 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409.

2. Movant is a member in good standing of the bar of the Commonwealth of Virginia and an attorney admitted to practice before the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Virginia.

3. David Cox is a member in good standing of the bar of California and is admitted to practice before the United States District Courts for the Central, Eastern, Southern, and Northern Districts of California, and the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit. There are no disciplinary proceedings pending against him in any jurisdiction.

4. Movant requests that this Court authorize Mr. Cox to appear and be heard at hearings and otherwise to participate in the Bankruptcy Case and all related proceedings on behalf of the Committee.

5. The Committee has selected Mr. Cox and other attorneys of Morgan Lewis to serve as the Committee's special insurance counsel.

6. Mr. Cox's application is appended to this Motion as Exhibit B and incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.

7. Notice of this Motion will be provided via CM/ECF electronic notification to all parties registered to receive such notice in the Bankruptcy Case as of the time of service. Given the nature of the relief requested, Movant submits that no further notice is necessary.

For the reasons explained above, Movant requests that this Court enter an Order (a) authorizing Mr. Cox to appear *pro hac vice* in the Bankruptcy Case and all related proceedings

on behalf of the Committee and (b) granting the Movant such other and further relief as the Court may deem proper.
