PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that if you do not want the Court to grant the relief requested in the Application, or if you want the Court to consider your views on the Application, then, by **October 1, 2024** (the “**Response Deadline**”), you or your attorney must:

- File with the Court, either electronically or at the address shown below, a written response to the Application pursuant to Rule 9013-1(G) of the Local Rules of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Virginia and the Case Management Procedures. If you mail your written response to the Court for filing, you must mail it early enough so the Court will **receive it** on or before the Response Deadline.

If a response is not properly and timely filed and served, the Court may deem any opposition waived, treat the Application as conceded and enter appropriate orders granting the requested relief without further notice or hearing.
