**ORDER GRANTING FIFTH INTERIM APPLICATION OF
HUNTON ANDREWS KURTH LLP, COUNSEL FOR THE DEBTOR
AND DEBTOR IN POSSESSION, FOR ALLOWANCE OF INTERIM COMPENSATION
AND REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES INCURRED FOR THE PERIOD FROM
JUNE 1, 2025 THROUGH AND INCLUDING AUGUST 31, 2025**

Upon consideration of the Fifth Interim Fee Application (the “Application”)¹ of Hunton Andrews Kurth LLP (“Hunton”), counsel for Hopeman Brothers, Inc., as debtor and debtor in possession (the “Debtor”), for the period from June 1, 2025, through and including August 31, 2025 (the “Fifth Interim Application Period”); and the Court having reviewed the Application and the Monthly Statements that were served by Hunton during the Fifth Interim Application Period, and finding that the Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334, and determining that proper and adequate notice has been given and that no other or further notice

is necessary; and after due deliberation thereon; and good and sufficient cause appearing therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The Application is GRANTED.
2. Hunton is allowed interim compensation in the amount of \$1,986,868.00 and reimbursement of expenses in the amount of \$43,730.76 for the Fifth Interim Application Period as requested in the Application.
3. The Debtor is authorized and directed to disburse to Hunton payment in the amount of the difference between the allowed amounts and the actual monthly payments previously received by Hunton for fees and expenses incurred during the Fifth Interim Application Period.
4. The Debtor is authorized and empowered to take such actions as may be necessary and appropriate to implement the terms of this Order.
5. This Court shall retain jurisdiction with respect to all matters relating to the interpretation or implementation of this Order.
6. This Order shall be effective immediately upon entry.
