

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Upon review of Deerfield Partners, L.P.'s *Application for Order Shortening Time* (the "Application")<sup>2</sup> for entry of an order (this "Order") requesting that the time period for Deerfield's Motion to Compel Deposition and Production of Documents by Baker Bros. Advisors LP (the "Motion to Compel") be shortened pursuant to Fed. R. Bankr. P. 9006(c)(1).
