SUPPLEMENTAL CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE

1. I, Heather Fellows, depose and say that I am employed by Kurtzman Carson Consultants, LLC dba Verita Global (“Verita”), the claims and noticing agent for the Debtors in the above-captioned case. I submit this Supplemental Certificate in connection with the service of solicitation materials for the *Amended Joint Plan of Invitae Corporation and its Debtor Affiliates Pursuant to Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code* (Docket No. 630) (the “Plan”) and the *Disclosure Statement Relating to the Amended Joint Plan of Invitae Corporation and Its Debtor Affiliates Pursuant to Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code* (Docket No. 631) (the “Disclosure Statement”). I am over the age of 18 and not a party to this action. Except as otherwise noted, I could and would testify to the following based upon my personal knowledge.

2. On February 16, 2024, the Court entered the *Order Authorizing the Appointment of Kurtzman Carson Consultants LLC as Claims and Noticing Agent Effective as of the Petition Date* (Docket No. 49).

3. On April 23, 2024, the Court entered the *Order Authorizing the Debtors to Employ and Retain Kurtzman Carson Consultants LLC as Administrative Advisor Effective as of the Petition Date* (Docket No. 354).

4. Consistent with its retention as claims and noticing agent, Verita is charged with, among other things, printing and distributing Solicitation Packages² to creditors and other interested parties pursuant to the solicitation and voting procedures within the *Order Approving (I) the Adequacy of the Disclosure Statement, (II) the Solicitation and Voting Procedures, (III) the Forms of Ballots and Notices in Connection Therewith, and (IV) Certain Dates with Respect Thereto* (Docket No. 633) (the “Disclosure Statement Order”) entered on June 13, 2024.
