APPLICATION FOR PAYMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE CLAIM

Life Technologies Corporation. a division of Thermo Fisher Scientific, by and through its undersigned counsel, files this Application for Allowance and Payment of Administrative Expense Priority Claim Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 503(b)(1) and 503(b)(9) (the "Application"), and in support thereof, states as follows.

JURISDICTION AND VENUE

- 1. This Court has jurisdiction to consider this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334.
- 2. Venue in the District of New Jersey is appropriate under 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409.
 - 3. This is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b).
- 4. Life Technologies filed its Proof of Claim at claim 910 wherein it asserted entitled to an administrative expense claim of \$142,689.18. reserving the right to amend as additional postpetition goods/services were provided.
- 5. Debtors continued to obtain additional goods on a post-petition basis and the amount due (as set forth in Exhibit "A" and inclusive of some or all of the amounts set forth in the filed claim) is now \$180,030.44.
- 6. Life Technologies is entitled to, and seeks payment of the asserted administrative claim in the amended amount of \$180,030.44, amending the previously asserted \$142,689.18.

BASIS FOR REQUESTED RELIEF

- 7. Section 503(b)(1)(A) of the Bankruptcy Code states that "the actual, necessary costs and expenses of preserving the estate" shall be allowed administrative expenses that are entitled to priority under section 507(a)(2) of the Bankruptcy Code. 11 U.S.C. § 503(b)(1)(A); 11 U.S.C. § 507(a)(2).
- 8. Pursuant to section 503(b)(9) of the Bankruptcy Code, after notice and a hearing, "there shall be allowed, administrative expenses, . . . including . . . (9) the value of any goods received by the debtor within 20 days before the date of commencement of a case under this title

in which the goods have been sold to the debtor in the ordinary course of such debtor's business." 11 U.S.C. § 503(b)(9).

- 9. "Goods", for purposes of section 503(b)(9), is not defined in the Bankruptcy Code; however, this Court has utilized the definition set forth in Article 2-105(1) of the Uniform Commercial Code (the "UCC"), which defines "goods" as "all things (including specially manufactured goods) which are movable at the time of identification to the contract for sale other than the money in which the price is to be paid, investment securities (Article 8) and things in action." UCC § 2-105(1).
- 10. As of the date of this Application, Life Technologies has not received payment of the \$180,030.44.
- 11. Life Technologies requests that the Court allow its Administrative Claim in the amount of \$180,030.44 and direct the immediate payment of the same.

NO PRIOR REQUEST

12. Except for the proof of claim setting forth Life Technologies' administrative claim, no prior request for the relief sought in this Application has been made to this Court or any other Court.

RESERVATION OF RIGHTS

13. Life Technologies reserves all rights and remedies with regard to the amounts and claims identified herein, including, without limitation, the right to amend, supplement, or clarify this claim as allowed by contract and under applicable law.

WHEREFORE, Life Technologies prays this Honorable Court allow and immediate payment of the \$180,030.44 to Life Technologies, and to grant such additional relief as the Court deems just and proper.
