analysis and findings based on the current record; and it is further

ORDERED that the Bankruptcy Court's approval of the Debtor Releases contained in

Article VIII of the Plan is REMANDED for further analysis and findings based on the current

record; and it is further

ORDERED that within thirty (30) days of the Bankruptcy Court's issuance of its revised

analysis and findings, Appellant shall file a letter to the docket advising this Court as to whether it

intends to continue its appeal; and it is further

ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court shall ADMINISTRATIVELY TERMINATE

this matter until the filing of Appellant's letter.
