ORDER GRANTING EMERGENCY EX PARTE  
MOTION TO SHORTEN TIME ON VARIOUS  
“FIRST-DAY” MOTIONS AND REQUEST FOR  
PERMISSION TO APPEAR REMOTELY

For good cause appearing, the Debtor's Emergency Motion To Shorten Time On Various “First-Day” Motions And Request For Permission To Appear Remotely (ECF No. 16) filed by Imperial Pacific International (CNMI), LLC, the debtor and debtor-in-possession in the above-captioned case (“Debtor”), is GRANTED. On April 26, 2024 at 8:30 a.m. this Court shall hold a hearing to consider the following “First-Day Motions”:

1. Application to Employ Choi & Ito and McDonald Law Office as Co-Counsel for the Debtor (ECF No. 10);
2. Pro Hac Vice Application for Chuck C. Choi, Esq. (ECF No. 7);
3. Pro Hac Vice Application for Allison A. Ito, Esq. (ECF No. 8);
4. Application to Employ Michael Chen Law Offices as special litigation counsel for the Debtor (ECF No. 13);
5. Motion for Interim Fee Procedures (ECF No. 9);
6. Motion For Order Authorizing Debtor to Pay Pre-Petition Wages and Other Employment-Related Costs And Expenses (ECF No. 11); and
7. Motion For Order Authorizing Debtor to Obtain Postpetition Secured Indebtedness (ECF No. 12).



1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the Debtor, through its proposed counsel or otherwise, shall  
2 provide this order and notice of the hearing to consider First Day Motions by telephone, facsimile,  
3 mail, hand-delivery or e-mail, to at least the following parties:

- 4 a. Office of the United States Trustee;  
5 b. Debtor's twenty largest unsecured creditors;  
6 c. Internal Revenue Service;  
7 d. Commonwealth Casino Commission;  
8 e. Commonwealth Revenue and Taxation;  
9 f. Secured creditors; and  
10 g. Department of Public Lands for Northern Mariana Islands.

12 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **any opposition to the First Day Motions shall be filed and**  
13 **served upon counsel for the Debtor up until the time of the hearing.**

14 The Debtor's proposed counsel (Charles McDonald of the McDonald Law Office, Chuck  
15 C. Choi, Esq. and Allison A. Ito, Esq., of Choi & Ito, Attorneys at Law, and Michael Chen, Esq.,  
16 of the Michael Chen Law Offices) may appear by video-conference or by telephone at this hearing  
17 and all future hearings in this matter.
