The *FIRST INTERIM FEE APPLICATION OF MCDONALD LAW OFFICE, AS
DEBTOR'S LOCAL BANKRUPTCY COUNSEL, FOR THE PERIOD APRIL 18, 2024 TO
OCTOBER 15, 2025* (the "Application") filed by McDonald Law Office ("Applicant"),
as special litigation counsel to IMPERIAL PACIFIC INTERNATIONAL (CNMI), LLC



(the “Debtor”), on October 31, 2025, came on for a remote hearing before the Honorable Robert J. Faris on December 5, 2025 (ChST), pursuant to notice to creditors and interested parties.¹ All appearances were noted on the record. The Court having considered the Application and supporting documents filed in support thereto, the Notice of Voluntary Reduction in Fees filed by the UST as docket # 494 (the “Fee Reduction Notice”), and the statements of the parties, and having reviewed the records and files in this case, and having determined that due and sufficient notice of the Application was given, and good cause appearing therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Application is hereby approved on an interim basis in the adjusted amount under the Fee Reduction Notice. Applicant is allowed \$20,501.25 in fees, \$2,782.64 in actual and necessary expenses, and \$1,091.75 in gross receipts tax, for a total of \$24,375.64, for the period April 18, 2024, through October 15, 2025. The amounts awarded are hereunder subject to final review and approval under Section 330 of the Bankruptcy Code.
