In furtherance of this resolution, United shall not seek to otherwise recoup from the Debtors any amounts due and owing under the Agreements that arose between June 2, 2024 through June 1, 2025, as such amounts shall be deemed satisfied in full through payment of the Administrative Expense Claim.
- 4. The Debtors are authorized and directed to pay the full amount of the Administrative Expense Claim within two weeks upon the date of the entry of this order.
- 5. Counsel for United shall serve a copy of this Order on all parties served with the Motion and file a certificate of service within three (3) days from the entry of this Order showing such service.
- 6. This Court shall retain jurisdiction to hear and determine all matters arising from the implementation and interpretation of this order.
