hearing on the Request on November 20, 2025 (the "Hearing") [Docket No. 1237]; and the Certification of Counsel Submitting a Revised Proposed Order Granting UnitedHealthcare Insurance Company's Motion for Allowance and Payment of Administrative Expense Claim (the "Affidavit") having been filed with the Court on November 3, 2025, in support of the Request [Docket No. 1252]; and it appearing that the Court has jurisdiction to consider the request pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; and it appearing that venue is proper pursuant 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409; and it appearing that this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2); and after due deliberation, and sufficient cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The Request is GRANTED as set forth herein.
- 2. United is hereby granted an allowed, liquidated administrative expense claim in the amount of \$75,247.90 pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 503(b)(1)(A) for unpaid post-petition obligations (the "Administrative Expense Claim"). The Administrative Expense Claim shall not be subject to any offsets.
- 3. In furtherance of this resolution, United shall not seek to otherwise recoup from the Debtors any amounts due and owing under the Agreements that arose between June 2, 2024 through June 1, 2025, as such amounts shall be deemed satisfied in full through payment of the Administrative Expense Claim.
- 4. The Debtors are authorized to pay the full amount of the Administrative Expense Claim within two weeks upon the date of the entry of this order.
- 5. Counsel for United shall serve a copy of this Order on all parties served with the Motion and file a certificate of service within three (3) days from the entry of this Order showing such service.

6. This Court shall retain jurisdiction to hear and determine all matters arising from the implementation and interpretation of this order.
