Upon consideration of *the GUC Trustee's Motion for Entry of an Order Extending the Claims Objection Deadline* [Docket No. 1245] (the "Motion")² filed on October 27, 2025; and the Court having found jurisdiction over the Motion pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1334 and 157(b); and

having found that venue is proper in this district pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§1408 and 1409 and this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b); and having found that Movant filed a notice setting the Motion for a hearing on November 20, 2025; and having found that notice was provided pursuant to applicable procedures and the *Fifth Amended and Restated General Order 24-2018*, and no objection to the Motion was filed prior to the applicable objection deadline; and having found that the Court has considered the Motion, including the lack of objection thereto; and after due deliberation the Court having determined that good causes exists for the relief requested in the Motion; and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor; it is hereby

ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED THAT:

1. The Motion is **GRANTED** as set forth herein.
2. The Claims Objection Deadline is hereby extended through and including May 27, 2026, without prejudice to the right to seek a further extension.
3. All time periods set forth in this Order shall be calculated in accordance with Bankruptcy Rule 9006(a).
4. The GUC Trustee is authorized to take all actions necessary to effectuate the relief granted in this Order in accordance with the Motion.
5. Counsel for the GUC Trustee shall serve a copy of this Order on all parties served with the Motion and file a certificate of service within three (3) days from the entry of this Order showing such service.
6. Notwithstanding anything in the Bankruptcy Rules, this Order is effective immediately upon its entry.

7. This Court retains jurisdiction with respect to all matters arising from or related to the implementation, interpretation, and enforcement of this Order.
