Upon the motion (the "Leave Request")² of the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors in

2 *Committee of Unsecured Creditors for Substantive Consolidation of Debtor Lefever Mattson and KS*
3 *Mattson Partners, LP and for Related Relief; and Memorandum of Points and Authorities* [filed as
4 both Doc. No. 1585 in Case No. 24-10545 (CN) and Doc. No. 157 in Case No. 24-10715 (CN) (the
5 “Substantive Consolidation Motion”); and the Court having found it has jurisdiction over this matter;
6 and the Court having found and determined that notice of the Leave Request by ECF is reasonable and
7 sufficient under the circumstances, and no other or further notice need be provided; and the relief
8 requested in the Leave Request being in the best interests of the Debtors’ estates in both of the above-
9 captioned bankruptcy estates, their creditors, and other parties in interest; and after due deliberation
10 and sufficient cause appearing therefor,

11 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

- 12 1. The Leave Request is GRANTED.
- 13 2. The Committee is authorized to file and serve the Substantive Consolidation Motion
14 not to exceed 32 pages (excluding declarations and exhibits).
- 15 3. This Court shall retain jurisdiction to hear and determine all matters arising from or
16 related to the implementation, interpretation, or enforcement of this Order.
