4 **PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that on August 6, 2024, Windscape Apartments, LLC filed a
5 voluntary petition for relief under chapter 11 of title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy
6 Code") in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of California (Santa Rosa
7 Division) (the "Bankruptcy Court").

8 **PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE** that on September 12, 2024, LeFever Mattson, a
9 California corporation ("LeFever Mattson"), and 57 affiliated entities (the "September 12
10 Debtors") filed voluntary petitions for relief under chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code.

11 **PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE** that on October 2, 2024, Pinewood
12 Condominiums, LP and Ponderosa Pines, LP, both affiliates of LeFever Mattson, filed voluntary
13 petitions for relief under chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code (the "October 2 Debtors," and
14 collectively with Windscape Apartments, LLC and the September 12 Debtors, the "Debtors").²
15 The bankruptcy cases of the Debtors are being jointly administered for procedural purposes only
16 (the "Chapter 11 Cases").

17 **PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE** that on December 9, 2025, the Debtors filed the
18 *Objection to Claim of Casey Thompson (Proof of Claim No. 1248)* (the "Objection"). By the
19 Objection, the Debtors seek to disallow and expunge Proof of Claim No. 1248 (the "Claim"), filed
20 by Casey Thompson (the "Claimant"), in its entirety. In deciding the Objection, the Court may
21 consider any other document filed in these Chapter 11 Cases.

22 **PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE** that the hearing on the Objection has been set for
23 **February 11, 2026, at 11:00 a.m. (Pacific Time)** (the "Hearing"), before the Honorable Charles
24 Novack, United States Bankruptcy Judge.

25 **P PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE** that if the Claimant opposes the disallowance
26 of the Claim referenced above, then pursuant to Bankruptcy Local Rule 9014-1(c)(1), any response
27 (the "Response") to the Objection must be filed with the Bankruptcy Court and served on counsel
28 for the Debtors no later than **January 28, 2026**.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that, if factual disputes are presented by the
Objection and any timely Response thereto, the Hearing will proceed as a status conference; factual
disputes will not be decided at the Hearing, but at a future evidentiary hearing that may be set at
the Hearing. Issues of a purely legal nature, where facts are not in dispute, may be decided at the
Hearing. See Bankruptcy Local Rule 3007-1(b).

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that counsel, parties, and other interested parties
may attend in person in Courtroom 215 in Oakland, by Zoom video, or by Zoom telephone.
Additional information is available on Judge Novack's Procedures page on the Bankruptcy Court's
